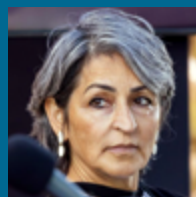

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Political destruction of economy

Government increased taxation is suffocating any chance of growth

BRITAIN’S new Labour Government has managed in six months to reduce an economy growing at the fastest rate in the G7 group of leading economies to falls of -0.1 per cent in both September and October 2024.

There has been no growth in the large services sector, as fearful consumers reduced spending and business paused investment. With manufacturing and construction declining at a pace of 0.6 per cent and 0.4 per cent respectively in October, annual inflation rose to 2.6 per cent.

The generosity distributed by Prime Minister Keir Starmer and Chancellor Rachel Reeves to doctors, train drivers and the nationalised sickness service (NHS – £25 bn extra) led to a budget in which the state raised taxes by a staggering £40bn, increased the minimum wage, increased already crippling business rates and increased employers’ national insurance payments

for each worker.

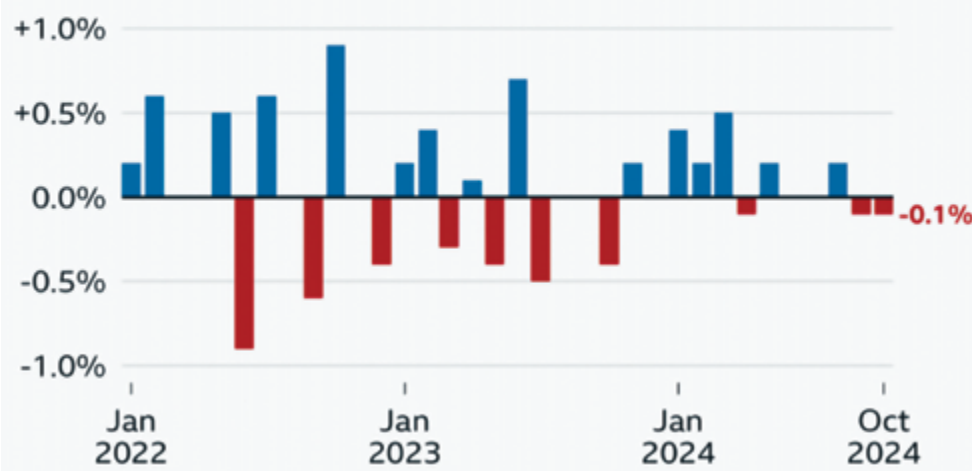
All this was in order to ‘go for economic growth’, but even the Office for Budget Responsibility understandably predicted the budget would make business investment weaker, and the Bank of England reduced its growth forecast to zero in the fourth quarter of 2024.

The state-dominated British economy impoverishes everyone. An analysis by The TaxPayers’ Alliance showed that the average household will pay over £1.2m in tax in their lifetime, meaning they would have to work for 19.5 years just to pay off the taxman.

Even the bottom 20 per cent of households, or families with a household gross income of £19,599, will work for almost 23.4 years to pay off their lifetime tax bill, the longest of any group since taxes long ago stopped taxing income and instead taxed existence, property and jobs.

Since 2020, the state sector has taken on an extra 250,000 employees to add to its appalling low productivity record.

Reeves’ solution is to reduce that by a mere 10,000 and ask departments for 5 per cent savings on their budgets. The international competitiveness of the UK is quite horrific.

The three critical elements in economic growth are capital, income returns and investment optimism. The budget seemed designed to destroy all three.

For decades, taxes have come increasingly from indirect sources unrelated to actual earnings or profits and, therefore, are unresponsive to slower or negative economic growth. The state demands its right to spend, unconstrained by the ability of the economy to finance its spending.

Just how unconstrained the state has become was revealed in the purchase by a government department of two leather-bound files for £1,200! A small example of a major failure.

The degree to which this disastrous government fails to understand the very concept of capital was revealed in their application of inheritance tax to family businesses and farms, where they actually believe that such businesses can lose 20 per cent of their capital and still function. To tax those families who sell out their capital for a one-off gain, or those who do not farm but buy land as a tax avoidance scheme has a logic to it, but to cripple ongoing businesses as one generation dies is madness.

Just how mad we can see by the fact that the government will not apply inheritance tax every 30 years to the biggest and richest corporations in the country – who are then at liberty to buy up the family firms and farm land which inheritance tax

has made unviable. No wonder Bill Gates and the banks are buying up farmland.

The TaxPayers’ Alliance found that, as the UK is sending farmers abroad over £516m in foreign aid, the inheritance tax changes announced at the Budget will raise £520m for the Treasury.

Just as the previous government sacrificed democratic capitalism for state corporatism, so this Labour government is a state corporatist government – socialism, big state, big corporations and supranational power.

One would think it could get no worse – but the government seems determined to wipe out major industries like oil and gas, cars, petrochemicals, steel and plastics on the altar of net zero. The implications for unemployment, the resulting welfare needs and the fall in taxes are dire.

No wonder company start-ups are the lowest for 13 years, 13,500 high street shops closed last year with even more expected in the next twelve months, and the London Stock Exchange is losing company quotations to Wall Street.

After 27 years of state corporatist and socialist policies under both Labour and Conservative governments, what was needed was a radical, democratic capitalist, free-trading, entrepreneurial, socially emancipatory (as opposed to state controlling) government.

Instead, since July 4, we have the same social decadence, political authoritarianism, financial bankruptcy and business ignorance as before – but in spades.

‘Our mum was murdered by NHS’

Midazolam and morphine administered hours before death

WHEN Barbara Clarke’s beloved husband Charles died in July 2021, a terrible grief took hold of her.

The couple had been married for 55 years and, as Charles’s carer since his stroke a few years previously, they were together pretty much 24 hours a day.

Son Steve Clarke, 58, says: “Mum, as you can imagine, was devastated. I, along with my six siblings, had never seen her so sad and she took to her bed. She was like this for a couple of days and we became concerned. We reckoned it was a case of Mum being broken-hearted. But, of course, we were worried that she may have been physically unwell too.”

According to Steve’s 56-year-old sister Deborah, until the death of their dad, Barbara was in great health. “Mum was incredible for her age – 76 – and was so full of energy, she’d have put many 40-year-olds to shame,” Deborah smiles. “She would happily jump on a bus from her home in Feltham to Shepherds Bush Market to buy her meat and fish without a problem.”

The fact that Barbara was always busy made it all the more surprising that she had taken to her bed. The family were worried, so made a decision on July 29, two days after she lost her husband, to call an ambulance to get Barbara checked out.

Steve recalled: “She had a slight temperature and there was a possibility she had a chest infection. Her SATs were good though, with oxygen levels at 99 per cent. I felt confident that she’d be fine and would be home in no time. How wrong I was!”

Deborah continued: “The following day, we were informed that she had been moved to a covid ward; none of us had been told she’d even been tested. We wondered what the hell was going on. Steve spoke to Mum on her first and second day at the hospital and she said she was feeling so much better and had no trouble breathing.

“She commented that there were people on the ward, single and double vaxxed, coughing and spluttering all around her. She was expecting to be released that day. However, for reasons unknown to us, she was not allowed to go home and we later found out she was being given oxygen by way of a CPAP (continuous positive airway pressure) machine. We had no idea why. She had been able to hold a conversation with my brother earlier that day with no

shortness of breath whatsoever.”

Later that day, after Steve and Deborah had left the hospital, an NHS worker called to inform the family that Barbara had been put on morphine. “This rang alarm bells for us,” says Deborah, “and when I asked why, we were told that it was only a small dose to help with ‘an uncomfortable mask’! I don’t think I’ve ever heard anything so ridiculous in my life.”

The following morning, a doctor called Deborah and asked for the family to come in at 3pm that day.

They got to the ward early and Steve and Deborah were told that it was a “matter of time” and that their mother was coming to the end of her life. “My heart broke right there and then,” Steve said. “I felt like I was in a nightmare, I felt destroyed.”

At 3pm the rest of the family arrived and were all taken to a room, where they were told again that Barbara was coming to the end of her life. The seven siblings were baffled and horrified.

Steve said: “They didn’t know our mum at all and were viewing her as some kind of housebound, decrepit old person and weren’t seeing her for what she was - a strong woman. I was so angry, so hurt and so bloody sad. I cried loudly and

uncontrollably along with my brothers and sisters.

“Looking back now, I can remember how uncomfortable the two doctors seemed to be - they couldn’t look us in the eye. Why?”

Steve and Deborah claim one of the doctors then said: “If you can learn anything from this, it’s to get you and your family vaccinated.”

Steve asked: “Is that why my mum didn’t survive the hospital stay, because of her vaccination status? I believe it was.”

After the meeting, the family accompanied Barbara as she was moved to a side ward and, with the morphine wearing off, she started to come round. The CPAP mask had been removed and oxygen was being administered via her nose. “The first thing she said to us,” recalls Deborah, “was ‘I’m hungry!’ Her mouth was so dry, her tongue was white and looked as though it had a layer of fur on it. She’d clearly had no food or water for days.”

Steve remembers that his mum then said: “There’s nothing wrong with me – they’re trying to keep me here.” She then went on to say she wanted to go home. Later that night – on August 8, 2021, just 12 days after her dear husband died – my

beautiful kind mum took her last breath, and my heart broke into a million pieces.”

The Clarke family wholeheartedly believes that Barbara was taken into hospital and treated for covid using a protocol - possibly NICE guideline NG163. They also believe that the fact she was unvaccinated was held against her. They say that, because she was pumped with oxygen she did not need for 24 hours a day, her lungs were destroyed.

They claim she was given unnecessary doses of morphine for three days before she died and that a syringe driver to administer midazolam was fitted. All this came to light after the family requested Barbara’s medical records.

Steve says: “Three years on, and I’m still angry. I can’t put into words how I feel about those two heartless doctors. I won’t leave it, I won’t forget about it. I intend to do my utmost to get justice. How I’ll get it, I don’t know but I’m a man of my word and I will keep going until I do.”

Deborah concludes: “There’s now absolutely no doubt in any of our minds that our lovely vibrant mum was murdered, euthanised by the people who were meant to care for her. And that’s something we can never forgive.”

Big tech's empire state

Silicon Valley runs world from behind facade of politics

THROUGHOUT the ages, many self-serving individuals and groups have positioned themselves as rulers, financiers, benefactors, and thought leaders – to steer change towards preferred outcomes.

From the pharaohs of ancient Egypt to the Jacobin and Napoleon-led French Revolution in the late 18th century, societal transformation has been constant, as one form of government replaces another.

We have now arrived at yet another historical inflection point. The desire for political and economic reconstruction is being demanded globally as the gap between the ultra-wealthy and everyone else continues to accelerate.

In recent years, populism has taken flight by inspiring the masses to reject the rule of 'the elite' and chart a new course. However, without scrutiny, this movement and its key figures could be just as dangerous as the establishment they are attempting to usurp. In fact, what we are witnessing is not populism in its truest sense but techno-populism, or technocracy, as it has been called since its inception in 1920.

Technocracy can be defined simply as an impersonal and scientific method of managing all aspects of a society. Its primary concerns deal with how energy is produced and used. But it goes much deeper than this.

One of the best explanations can be found in an issue of *The Technocrat* magazine from September 1937, where it states: 'Technocracy is the science of social engineering, the scientific operation of the entire social mechanism to produce and distribute goods and services to the entire population of this continent. For the first time in human history it will be done as a scientific, technical, engineering problem. There will be no place for politics or politicians, finance or financiers, rackets or racketeers.'

The technocratic dream is revolutionary in scope, envisioning a total reorganisation of industry, government, and law and order. Technocrats readily admit their intent is to socially engineer all of society, seize control of the production and distribution of all goods and services, and rid the world of rule by politicians and traditional financial controllers.

The U.S. Constitution is also viewed as a relic, completely unfit to serve as a basis of governance and human rights. Edith Chamberlain, in the December 1964 edition of *The Technocrat*, wrote: 'Another job which has been neglected far too long is the rebuilding of our governmental machinery, from the village level right up to Congress.'

'It cannot be avoided much longer, simply because the country has outgrown the constitutional clothes which the Founding Fathers tailored for it nearly two centuries ago. They have become as anachronistic, and as impractical, as a Pilgrim's costume on an astronaut.'

Technocrats make no pretence about maintaining a representative form of government. Its goal is to establish a scientific dictatorship to initiate and control all societal functions. Technocrats distanced themselves and were highly critical of fascists, communists, socialists, and other political movements, but do not have a problem with their

Who are the technocrats?

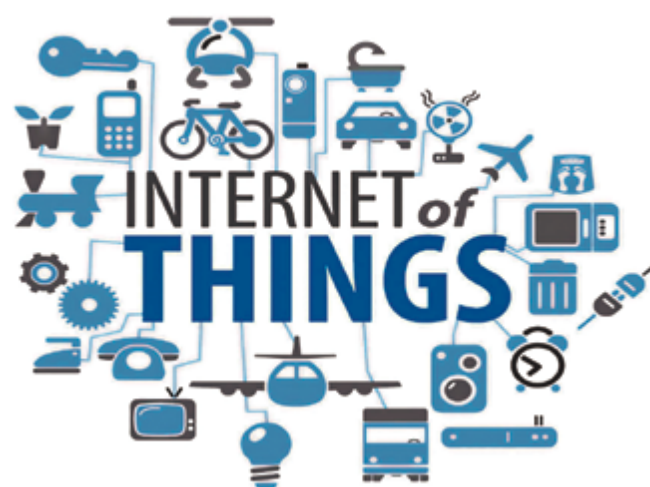
Silicon Valley is the seat of modern technocracy. Big Tech is the euphemism for which it's currently known. The World Economic Forum defines this dynamic as public-private partnerships (PPP).

Elon Musk, Peter Thiel, and Marc Andreessen are some of today's most prominent techno-populists. Many believe they are modern-day Justice League-type heroes leading the world to newfound freedom. All were major contributors to Donald Trump's re-election campaign in 2024. Vice President-Elect J.D. Vance has deep connections to Thiel, indicating how close technocrats truly are to running the country.

Jeff Bezos, Tim Cook, and Sam Altman are also among the many tech gurus aligning themselves with the newly elected Trump administration. These endorsements indicate that for now, technocrats are content with using politicians and the political system to quietly transform the government into a full-fledged Technate from the inside out and vice versa.

As explained by *The Technocrat* (December 1964): 'It is the man who has command of the technical information who makes the real decisions in the functional phases of modern life.'

'He is the only one who understands what needs to be done and how to do it. The politicians and financial manipulators who pretend that the right of decision is theirs are helpless without the technical men.'



own totalitarian style of rule, termed a Technate.

A December 1964 issue of *The Technocrat* magazine further explained: 'Technocracy holds that all decisions pertaining to the functional operation of the society - the production and distribution of goods and services, research, and governance - should be made by technical men and women.'

'This does not mean that the technical people should leave their technical positions and go into politics, law, business promotion, public relations, and moral philosophy. Rather, it means that the scientists, technologists, engineers, and technicians shall continue to operate as such and that the decision-making of the society be moved into their functional realms.'

A monumental reshaping of governments, economies, and societies is occurring, but not by elected representatives, constitutions, creeds, or the will of the people. Power is now concentrated in the hands of an exclusive class of scientists, technologists, engineers, and technicians - many of whom also happen to head multi-billion dollar corporations.

Why is technocracy rising now?

Promised 'golden age' is a front for 24/7 surveillance

If the human race on this continent is to survive the crash of the price system, technocracy will have to be put into practice.

Technocracy in Plain Terms, Technocracy Inc., 1939

TECHNOCRACY has long been resisted by traditional powers and was originally conceived for only the North American continent.

Today, technocracy is rising from the ashes, like the phoenix legend, to become a force to be reckoned with. I believe this is largely because of the pending economic meltdown.

The debt-based, fiat currency system is at the end of its life cycle and the central bank establishment is looking for new ways to maintain control of the monetary system. They have joined ranks with the technocrats who were correct in predicting that the system would crash (though it has yet to take place, due to manipulation tactics keeping it at bay).

By adopting technocracy, the bankers not only retain control over the monetary system, they also cement their rule over all industries, natural resources, governments, institutions and people.

Hopefully all the dots are starting to connect, enabling you to see where all of this is heading. Technocracy's ascendance is a threat to all of humanity. Technocrats promise a utopian existence where abundance is the norm and work is optional, if not completely unnecessary.

The self-appointed leaders believe they know best how to manage the world's resources and its people. To accomplish these lofty goals, the social structure will have to undergo drastic changes, which include redefining work and wages. The following excerpt from the Technocracy Study Course provides a detailed overview of what this entails.

If the production is to be non-oscillatory and maintained at a high level so as to provide a high standard of living, it follows that consumption must be kept equal to production, and that a system of distribution must be designed which will allow this. This system of distribution must do the following things:

1. Register on a continuous 24-hour

basis the total net conversion of energy, which would determine (a) the availability of energy for continental plant construction and maintenance, and (b) the amount of physical wealth available in the form of consumable goods and services for consumption by the total population during the balanced load period.

2. By means of the registration of energy converted and consumed, make possible a balanced load.
3. Provide a continuous 24-hour inventory of all production and consumption.
4. Provide a specific registration of the type, kind, etc., of all goods and services, where produced, and where used.
5. Provide specific registration of the consumption of each individual, plus a record and description of the individual.
6. Allow the citizen the widest latitude of choice in consuming his individual share of continental physical wealth.
7. Distribute goods and services to every member of the population

In short, the goal of technocracy is to micromanage everything you do, produce, and consume through non-stop surveillance. This was not technically possible with the crude paper methods proposed by early technocrats. However,

it is becoming achievable with the advent of digital technologies such as biometrics, Big Data, geospatial intelligence, digital currency, AI, and 5G.

In a Technate, there will be no free-market economy where the average person could obtain wealth by starting a business or embarking upon a lucrative career path. Instead, technocrats promise each person a share of the overall wealth produced through the issue of Energy Certificates.

The Technocracy Study Course (p.230) states: 'Under a technological administration of abundance, there is only one efficient method - employing a system of Energy Certificates...

'These certificates are merely pieces of paper containing certain printed matter. They are issued individually to every adult of the entire population. The certificates issued to an individual may be thought of as possessing some of the properties both of bank cheque and of a traveller's cheque.

'They would resemble a bank cheque in that they carry no face denomination. They receive their denomination only when being spent. They resemble a traveller's cheque in that they possess some means of ready identification, such as counter-signature, photograph, or some similar device, so as to establish easy identification by the person to whom issued, and at the same time remain absolutely useless in the hands of

anyone else.'

Today, Energy Certificates could take the form of Universal Basic/High Income payments issued in the form of central bank digital currency (CBDC) or some other form of digital currency. Corporate transactions could be conducted via carbon credits.

Regardless of the mechanism of financial transfer, the individual will be totally dependent on the Technate with everything one does requiring a digital ID.

The American dream of upward mobility, already heading towards extinction, will receive the knockout blow in a technocratic regime. Instead, compliance and energy usage will determine your level of prosperity. Property rights will also go out the window as the plan is to revolutionise housing into energy-efficient units with little variety and few manufacturers.

This could occur today through the combination of an economic crisis wiping out individual wealth and mass printing of 3D houses fit for the technocratic era.

As envisioned, technocracy is no better than communism, fascism, or socialism. It's just another power grab by individuals who believe they are smarter than the rest of us, with a promised utopia that will never materialise.

It is important for people everywhere to understand the implications of what is taking place and not be fooled by wolves in sheep's clothing proclaiming a new golden age of humanity is imminent.

The question is, a golden age for who?

Football authorities impose LGBT agenda

Players being pressured to back controversial rainbow lobby

ENGLISH international footballer Marc Guehi was recently reprimanded by the Football Association (FA) for writing 'I love Jesus' on his rainbow-coloured captain's armband during a match against Newcastle United.

Despite the dressing down by the FA, which was formed in the London Freemasons' Tavern in 1863, the captain of Premier League team Crystal Palace bravely doubled down by writing 'Jesus loves you' on his armband in a second match against Ipswich Town.

Defending his love for Jesus Christ, English defender Guehi told BBC Radio 5 Live: "It was just a message of truth and love and inclusivity. I don't think the message was harmful in any way - that's all I can say really about that to be honest.

"I believe 100 per cent in the words I wrote, even what I've just said now – it's a message of truth and love, and I hope people can understand that my faith is my faith, and I'll stand by it for the rest of my life."

The intrusive FA rainbow initiative, in collaboration with controversial LGBT charity Stonewall, is part of a 'Rainbow Laces Campaign' in the English football top flight, which expects captains from each team to adorn their jersey with the rainbow colours. The campaign, which has been going on for 11 years, calls on all clubs in the Premier League to adorn pitch flags, stadiums and jerseys with LGBT messaging.

Guehi, a devout Christian, has proudly spoken about the importance of faith in his life. He told football publication *The Athletic*: 'I've grown up loving God and when I have had the chance, I still go to church with my family, and my faith is a big part of my life.'

Guehi's father John, who is a Christian church minister, defended his son by telling the *Mail Online*: 'If you look at what the LGBT community are doing, they are trying to impose on others what they believe in. It's belief against belief, but at the end of the day, everyone has the right to an opinion.'

The FA currently bans any political, religious or personal messaging, statements or images on football kits. Despite the obvious double standards in pushing an overtly radical left, woke agenda, the FA reminded Ivory Coast-born Guehi of kit regulations when he mentioned Jesus on his jersey.

Meanwhile, Sam Morsy, captain of Ipswich Town in the Premier League and a practising Muslim, also took a stand against the FA/Stonewall rainbow campaign, by not adorning his armband with rainbow colours. Morsy cited religious beliefs as rationale for not complying with the rainbow-coloured endorsements.

In yet another act of defiance against the pervasive, partisan rainbow lobby in football, Manchester United defender Noussair Mazraoui refused to wear a club jacket that supported the Rainbow Laces Campaign. Moroccan-born Mazraoui cited religious grounds for non-compliance with the LGBT agenda.

It is not the first time that players across the top and lucrative soccer leagues in Europe have taken a stance against the rainbow brigade.

In 2022, then Paris Saint-Germain footballer Idrissa Gueye defied the fierce propaganda that comes with promoting LGBT rights by withdrawing from a Ligue 1 match in which he was expected to display the rainbow colours on his jersey. The practising Muslim from Senegal cited 'personal reasons' as the rationale for pulling out of the match against Montpellier, which was marking the International Day Against Homophobia, Biphobia and Transphobia.

Very few people who were critical of

Gueye mentioned the fact that French football giants PSG are owned by Tamin bin Hamad Al Tani from the Qatar Sports Investments. According to the Human Dignity Trust on its official website: 'The Constitution of Qatar designates Islam as the state religion, and Islamic Law as the main source of legislation. As such, in addition to the Penal Code, Qatar operates an interpretation of Sharia Law which criminalises sexual activity between men, under which it is possible that the death penalty can be imposed.'

The Senegalese President Macky Sall even showed his support for national soccer star Gueye by stating in an online post: 'I support Idrissa Gana Gueye. His religious convictions must be respected.' Gueye also received support from his Senegalese team-mates.

Brendan O'Neill, columnist with *The Spectator*, commented on the issue surrounding Gueye by saying: 'Pride, it seems to me, is no longer about celebrating gay freedom but rather has become a globalised orgy of virtue signalling. Adorning oneself or one's business in the rainbow colours is really a way of saying "I'm good. I'm nice. I have the correct view." And by extension, anyone who rejects the rainbow is viewed as suspect, as a sinner, as someone who might require a spot of re-education.'

The French Football Federation (FFF) at

the time shamefully blamed Gueye of 'validating discriminatory behaviour'.

In trying to bully and isolate Gueye, the ethics council of the FFF stated: 'There are two possibilities. Either these allegations are unfounded, and we invite you to speak without delay to silence the rumours. For example, we invite you to accompany your message with a photograph wearing said shirt. Or the rumours are true, and we invite you to realise the impact of your act, and the grave error committed.'

The FFF finished by adding that 'the impact of football on society and the capacity for footballers to be a role model for those who admire them gives us all a particular responsibility.'

The Royal College of Psychiatrists recently joined a long list of respectable organisations to give Stonewall the boot in the aftermath of the Cass Report, which highlighted the grave danger of pushing trans ideology and puberty-blocking drugs on young people.

Despite the ongoing major controversy surrounding Stonewall, the English FA continues to collaborate with it at the time of writing.

Giving vaccine injured a voice

Group for families harmed or killed by medical intervention

IT was finally here: the long-awaited vaccine injury awareness event at the parliamentary buildings of Northern Ireland.

Three vax-injured and bereaved parties had to visit the First Minister and Deputy to bravely deliver their testimonies in person before the awareness event at Stormont would be agreed to.

The occasion was organised by Vaccine Injured and Bereaved Support (VIBS) NI, a support network set up to represent and highlight the plight of the many victims of vaccine injury.

So the stage was set for the vax injury awareness event in Stormont. Democratic Unionist Party politician, Paul Frew, opened the speeches, and then there followed a plethora of stories of injury following vaccination. Hearing these stories firsthand was both shocking and heartbreaking. How could these 'safe and effective' jabs have caused such horrific injuries?

I sat beside a man called Billy who, himself, suffered horrendously after just one dose of the Pfizer covid-19 injection. He became seriously ill and was hospitalised within just seven days of his jab. He was then rushed into surgery as he was starting to go into multiple organ failure.

The surgeon performed a laparotomy where he was cut open and examined, yet nothing could be found. He spent two weeks in ICU fully ventilated and on life support, where his family was sent for twice over fears his life was ebbing away.

When he eventually came round, he had a further week and a half in hospital before being sent home with a Zimmer frame and in a bad way; very weak and needing to learn to walk again.

The ordeal was not over though, as a week later his heart was racing at 250 bpm, and he was rushed back to hospital by blue light ambulance, needing to have his heart shocked back to a normal heart rhythm. A cardiac MRI and an angiogram showed myocarditis and pericarditis (known vaccine injuries) and it was deemed necessary to fit an ICD pacemaker as a precaution. Although consultants tell him privately that his injuries are more than likely from the vaccine, they will not commit this diagnosis to paper.

This is very frustrating for Billy, who had been in perfect health before he got the vaccine, and all he wants is answers. It is now nearly four years later and he is no

further on. There has been no explanation from the medical world which was so keen to give him the vaccine that so nearly killed him and has left him with severe trauma and ongoing medical issues.

Billy's career has been decimated due to ill health, and he had to take a less stressful job with flexible hours so that he can attend his many medical appointments.

He, like a lot of vaccine-injured, feels badly let down and abandoned by the medical system that gaslights them and denies the obvious link. With the overwhelming evidence now available, and the brains of the medical world at hand, they must do better for those they have injured, and also call an immediate halt to these injections that can be lethal.

I spoke to Kenneth and Sharon who were instrumental in the setting up of VIBS NI. They told their heartbreaking story of losing their daughter, Ruth, a young and healthy 23-year-old who simply wanted to go to a

music festival in Leeds.

Needing a vax passport, she used a pop-up clinic and got a Pfizer jab in the arm to join her friends at the concert. What an expensive error of judgement for one so young as, within seven months, she caught a fever with flu-like symptoms and then 'died suddenly'.

This event would probably have gone under the radar and not even been linked to the Pfizer jab because the medics attending did not automatically record it. Only because of her mum Sharon, with her extensive nursing knowledge and understanding, was the vaccine link included in the medical notes.

At the subsequent autopsy, the coroner also failed to look into the vaccine link. It was necessary for Sharon, a grieving mother, to contact her GP in order to get a yellow card filled in for her sadly deceased daughter.

The yellow card system is supposed to be



the early warning system, designed to flag up potential issues with vaccines; yet it lies largely derelict and unused and even the deaths recorded there have never been vigorously investigated, which is what is supposed to happen. It is as if no-one cares for those who believed in and took the mRNA 'vaccines', but paid a heavy price when they got a severe and debilitating reaction or were even killed.

Stories such as these are the reason that VIBS NI was set up; to give a voice to people who are otherwise ignored. That the vaccine- and medical-injured have a voice is important for their sake, so they can get the recognition and the help they need.

It is also important for society so that such an event will never happen again and so that coercion cannot be applied, nor enforcement. In the words of the late activist Brandy Vaughan: 'Where there is risk, there must be choice.'

MRNA 'vaccines' must not become obligatory, which is what the rulers and the pharmaceutical world would like.

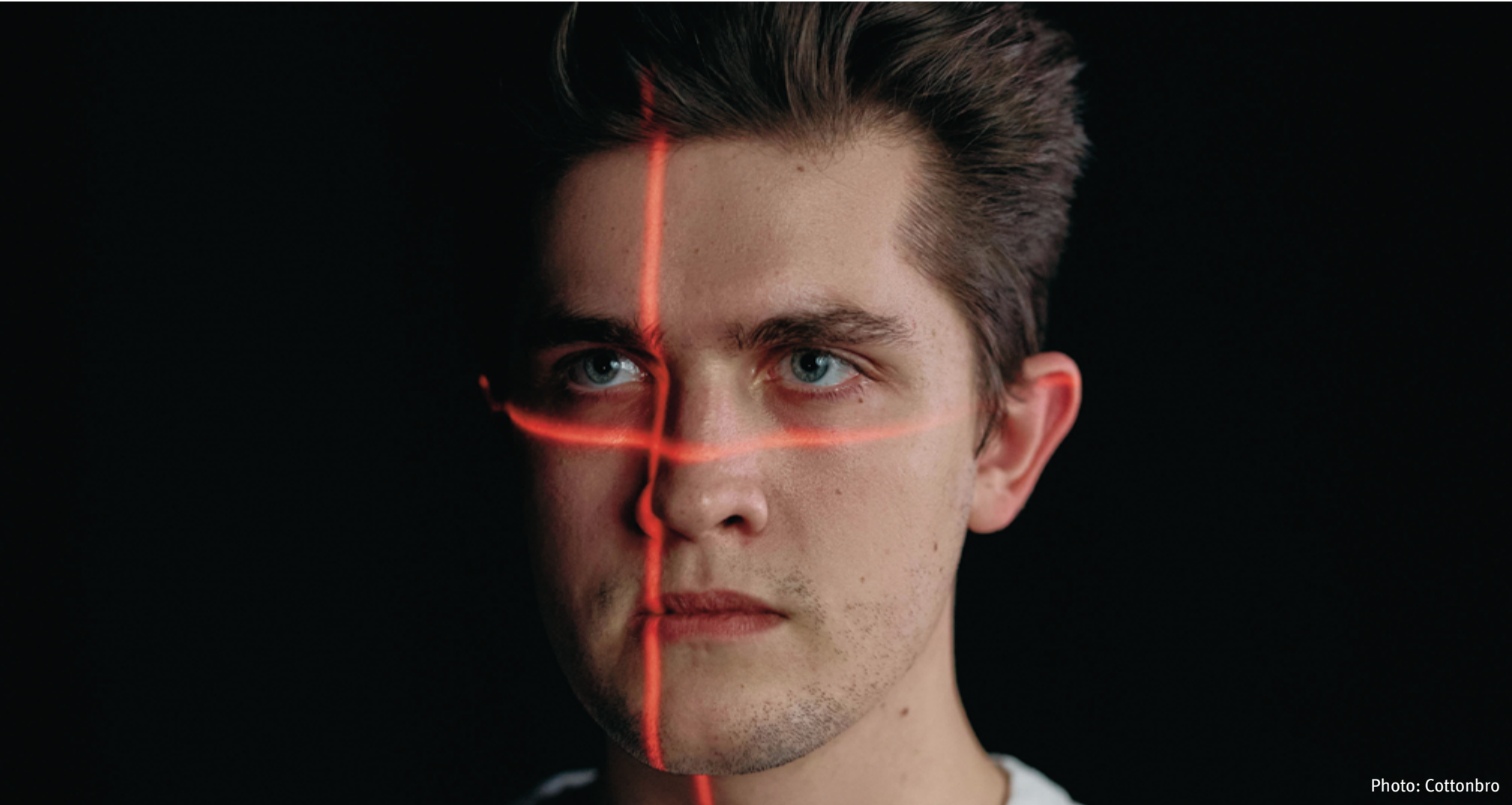
It is important for more and more people to join groups such as VIBS NI so that their voices will become stronger together and there will be networks of people helping and supporting each other.

Puppet governments eye digital ID

Child-safeguarding excuse to bring in adult surveillance

TO the detriment of us all, the majority of people take official messages at face value.

We saw this in the covid-19 debacle, and, while there is more scepticism about the claimed climate emergency, there is broadly gullible acceptance of the need to reduce carbon emissions.

Once the premises of debate are set, only the details are left for discussion.

So it is also with the purported mental health crisis in younger people, a scare emerging in the media over ten years ago. As a mental health lecturer, I was sceptical about this phenomenon, suspecting a Big Pharma ploy to expand their drug market. Now I believe society that was being primed for deprivation of liberty through the excuse of vulnerability of the young.

Critical thinkers can see that almost every policy nowadays is in tune with the ‘Great Reset’. The goal is an elite-run digital technocracy with totalitarian surveillance and a social credit system. Suppression of

free speech is crucial to the progress of this new world order.

The Online Safety Act, recently passed by the UK parliament, will be enforced next year, placing a burden on social media platforms such as Elon Musk’s X, to remove content deemed misinformation or hate (subjective entities used to impose ‘woke’ or other future statist ideology).

A government press release on the new statutory powers, on behalf of technology minister Peter Kyle, announced a major study of the impact of social media and smartphones on younger people ‘to strengthen the evidence needed to build a safer online world’.

The government has limited jurisdiction beyond its territory, but it is acting with other nations on a worldwide intervention (as with covid and climate change).

Ahead of the queue is Australia, where children are now barred from using social media. What this means is that everyone is barred unless they prove their age. For this, they will eventually need the Australian government’s proposed digital identity, which will include biometric data (through pupil scan).

Manufacturing crises is the modus operandi of the globalists. Emergency powers can be installed and never relinquished afterwards (for example, strict airport security now, after the World Trade Center event 24 years ago).

My research showed that there never really was a crisis of psychological distress in young people. I conducted two systematic reviews of research findings, a scientific exercise producing the highest level of evidence.

Cited 423 and 1,817 times respectively (according to Google Scholar), these were the most influential papers of my academic career.

If they took these systematic reviews seriously, the authorities would have tempered their message. The reality for young people is that spending most of their lives on their mobile devices is now the norm. You and I might think this is unhealthy for mind, body and soul, but mental health is normative, and people who struggle to follow norms are the most likely to become mentally ill – not those who are fitting in. So why is child safety pushed as a reason to restrict internet use?

As I warned years ago, the powers-that-be are weaponising mental health for authoritarian pursuits, such as medicalising dissent. But their objectives are always cast as beneficial and awkward to oppose – who wouldn’t support interventions to protect children from harm?

The real reason for restricting social media access to children is to introduce a comprehensive digital identity system. The rationale to achieve this will not always be protecting children. In the U.S. for example,

it could arise through the deliberately created crisis of illegal immigration, with president-elect Donald Trump pledging to stop this by all means necessary.

If the government was genuinely concerned for your children, it wouldn’t be jabbing them with experimental mRNA vaccines, exposing them to 5G and increasingly apparent chemtrails, while endangering them with a mass influx of undocumented migrants. And it wouldn’t have shut them out of schools for a contrived pandemic.

Always think beyond the headlines, beyond the stated purpose, to understand the real motives of laws and policies enacted by, what are effectively, puppet governments.

Confessions of a carer

Shocking revelations about patients being ‘drugged to death’

Whistleblower *Claudine Long* speaks to *Jacqui Deevoy* to reveal some of the horrors she witnessed during her 30-year career as a carer and explains how end-of-life protocols forced her to resign

I’VE been a carer my entire career and early on learned that, with the elderly, it’s all about the end. They dread it but also look forward to it and plan for it.

Rarely do family members get to know what goes on in their heads, but carers get to see that, as we’re there to provide emotional support as well as do all the practical stuff.

I was trained at 18 by BUPA, and it was the most thorough training. They were rigorous and strict. I loved the work, I felt competent and capable in my duties, and settled easily into the end-of-life side of care.

Matron ensured I had specific Last Offices training – how to contact the funeral director/coroner in case of out-of-hours deaths. My personal standards were set high to start with, backed up by a huge national health group, and our little care home won awards for being the best in their collection.

Skip forward 20-odd years and I started to witness changes in end-of-life care. I fought against them. None of us wanted the Liverpool Care Pathway, as it was obviously designed to sweep away – by that I mean kill off – the elderly in a very short timeframe.

I had skipped between residential nursing care and community care throughout my time in care, and the last residence I worked in had no end-of-life residents at all – it was just a posh hotel with staff on hand.

I went into community care in 2014/15 and helped grow a tiny company from two carers and one client into a thriving top-ten care company in the country. Within three years, we had dozens of clients and a solid base of ten carers.

Three years into my community care role, a manager asked if I would like to take on

67-year-old Mrs A, to provide support for her husband who had been caring for her alone. I went with another carer to meet the couple and find out Mrs A’s history.

She had suffered a brain aneurysm and survived it, but it had left her very disabled and with zero judgement.

Over the next few months, we helped her at home with all personal care, food prep and eating assistance and took her out

for walks with her little dogs. She needed constant supervision. Every day for about three months, we provided 12-hours-a-day care, split between four carers.

Soon after, the poor woman had a stroke and ended up in hospital with a suspected bleed on her brain. Whilst in hospital, her actions became extremely sluggish, she fell whenever she tried to stand, and lost all form of communication.

I was informed by my manager that she was coming home for palliative care only. There was a meeting with a doctor from the hospital, a social worker, her husband and one of my managers, who all agreed it was time for her to go.

During her last two weeks, she was sedated heavily but she still had some fight in her. I did not administer the end-of-life drugs – a visiting nurse came in twice a day to do that. She was given the usual mix of midazolam and morphine via a syringe driver. Mrs A pulled out the syringe driver several times – she clearly didn’t want it.

I was originally her main carer. But when I told my manager that Mrs A wasn’t ready to die and that she shouldn’t be on end-of-life medication, they changed my rota and reduced my visits without saying anything to me directly.

We were ordered to only wash and change her but not to give her any food or drinks. I gave her some mouth care – vital for those who are dying, as the mouth can dry out and become painful – and she sucked my finger so hard she left red marks through the wet sponge and would not let go.

This is not the action of someone who wants to die; it’s the action of someone who wants to live. I realised then she had been put on an end-of-life pathway identical to the Liverpool Care Pathway which was supposed to have been

abolished in 2014.

When I complained and said what we were doing didn’t feel right and that I felt complicit in murder, my manager looked at me in disbelief. I felt betrayed because they were usually very keen that we provided full-on support for our clients.

The carer I worked with agreed with me, and we noted our views in the care reports, so at least it was recorded that Mrs A demonstrated a will to live and a wish for food and drink.

While this was going on I received some very bad news about my mum – she was diagnosed with a brain tumour. I was given time off and stopped thinking about work.

My mum died within a few short weeks. I went back to work, but after what I had seen, my heart wasn’t in it any more. I asked a manager if there were any changes made to the end-of-life policy, and they told me there were not and that there was nothing wrong with what they were doing. I didn’t agree. That’s when I resigned.

Mrs A was dead by then. I was not with her when she died, but her family was

at her bedside at the very end. I went to her funeral and that was the last I saw of the family.

Telling my story has lifted a huge weight from me. It helps put it all away in a box in my head. For years, it’s felt like a huge lump in my chest. I feel better for sharing it.

I feel bitter and resentful that I had to give up the career I loved because of the callous end-of-life protocols, but I couldn’t do what they wanted me to do.

These policies involved murdering people – drugging them to death – and I didn’t want to be part of that. How anyone in a caring profession can do that, I just don’t know.

Whistleblowing and suppressing dissent in science

Richard House interviews Professor Brian Martin

Richard House [RH]: Can you share something of your own professional and academic journey, and how you came to be interested in the issue of dissent in medicine and science?

Brian Martin [BM]: It was the late 1970s. I was doing research in astrophysics at the Australian National University. I was also active in the environmental movement, and this was long before it became mainstream. I gradually learned about several environmental scientists and teachers whose articles had been blocked, their tenure denied, their access to data prevented, or their jobs terminated. It seemed to be a pattern. I investigated further and started writing about it and getting some publicity – this led to more people contacting me.

Over the years, my interest in the ‘suppression of dissent’ snowballed into a wide range of domains, such as controversies over nuclear power, pesticides, fluoridation and vaccination, all of which involve scientific and medical dimensions. In the 1990s, I became active in a new organisation, Whistleblowers Australia, and talked with many whistleblowers.

RH: It surely requires great integrity to take up such positions when one knows one’s career progression will be adversely affected.

BM: For sure, there is some risk in studying dissent. My career in science never took off – I was on one-year contracts for a decade, and was even terminated a couple of times; but it’s hard to be sure why, because others had difficulty too. There’s one sobering aspect of supporting whistleblowers: many of them have a really hard time, losing their jobs, their careers, their money, their health. Compared to them, I’ve been fortunate. Most people have no idea what it’s like to do what’s right and then come under a relentless attack.

RH: Your 1996 book, *Confronting the Experts* had a great impact on me; tell us about that book.

BM: In the 1970s and 1980s, I was part of the movement against nuclear power. We were up against two eminent pro-nuclear experts, Sir Ernest Titterton, a nuclear physicist, and Sir Philip Baxter, a nuclear engineer. Several of us engaged with them through letters and articles in the local newspaper, *The Canberra Times*. After several years, to aid anti-nuclear campaigners, I decided to write a critique of Titterton’s and Baxter’s views, and it came out as a pamphlet titled *Nuclear Knights*.

This engagement got me interested in how to challenge prestigious experts aligned with powerful enterprises. Years later, I decided to write a practical manual for how to challenge establishment experts. By that time, I had a job in the social sciences at the University of Wollongong in NSW, Australia. It took me two years to muster the courage to write this manual, titled *Strip the Experts*. In academia, the expectation is to be scholarly, to write for peers, not to go ‘downmarket’ and practical.

Strip the Experts wasn’t enough for me though. Over the years, I had gotten to know several courageous

and enterprising challengers who were experts themselves, but were up against powerful establishments. Two were my friends: Mark Diesendorf, a critic of fluoridation, and Sharon Beder, a critic of Sydney sewerage policy and practice. Others I knew through correspondence. So I had the idea of putting together this book in which each of them would share their experiences. Their stories, in diverse fields, showed striking parallels.

RH: Tell us about your research on whistleblowers.

BM: Due to my investigations into the suppression of dissent, I was aware of the issue of whistleblowing. Indeed, these are two ways of looking at the same thing: the focus in whistleblowing is on the whistleblower, whereas the focus in suppression of dissent is more on the perpetrator, the agent imposing suppression.

In the early 1990s, the organisation Whistleblowers Australia was set up. It is a self-help and mutual-help organisation; most members are whistleblowers.

I became president in 1996, and suddenly all sorts of whistleblowers wanted to talk

to me – teachers, police officers, public servants, company employees, health workers – you name it. I knew a lot before that, but I soon learned a lot more.

After repeatedly giving similar advice to callers, I felt like a broken record. So I decided to write a practical manual for whistleblowers, incorporating comments from several other experienced whistleblower advisers. Many people told me it was really helpful, and years later I prepared a new edition titled *Whistleblowing: A Practical Guide*.

Although I drew on research, writing a practical guide isn’t considered research because of a strange disjunction between theory and practice. There are volumes of research on whistleblowing, for example survey data and legal analyses, but hardly any of it is useful to actual whistleblowers.

My conclusion from years of involvement in the issue is that the usual approach – i.e. whistleblower protection via legislation – is inadequate. Just as important are the skills for bringing about organisational and social change.

RH: What are you working on at the moment?

BM: As an academic, it’s always been frustrating to see how scholars write mainly for each other, and seldom do research to help activists. But also, perhaps there is something activists can learn from academic work, so I set about trying to explain how to do this, while avoiding all the useless stuff.

After starting on this project, it seemed slightly dry and lifeless, so I decided to write *Sarah’s Day*, a fictional story illustrating features of university life. This led me to turn the entire thing into a story, a sort of ‘educational fiction’. Doing this was challenging, but it was also more fun than usual academic writing.

The short book should appear later in 2025 and will be free on my website, along with all my other writing.

David Kelly inquiry a whitewash

Official lines fed to media which repeats it as ‘truth’

LAST year marked the 20-year anniversary of the publication of the Hutton Report into the death of government scientist and expert on biological warfare David Kelly.

In the scientific community, there are no absolutes, only theories proposed from data collected. The theories depend on the quality of data and the quality of minds that formulate the theory. That’s what we have to recognise. Theories change over time due to new available data.

Against that background, we are faced with media that say a theory is the one truth. It is absolute. It is fed to the media via official channels. Official channels told the media David Kelly’s death was suicide.

Not long ago, 20 years after that shocking event, BBC Radio 4 rolled out a documentary ‘proving’ again that David Kelly, a man who once brought an Iraqi weapons expert to tears through interrogative questioning, was so upset at the public circus around his frank but not unusual conversation with journalist, Andrew Gilligan, that he decided to end it all:

- Without a suicide note to his wife
- Just before his daughter’s wedding
- Just after announcing to a publisher he was thinking of writing a book
- Just after mentioning to a colleague he was thinking of resigning from the Ministry of Defence who underpaid him, and taking a position in America, where he could get better money and better health care for his sick wife

As already established, there are no absolutes. For example, the complex dynamics of our climate show us that massively long cycles of change are a factor, and human involvement in climate change may be as little as 4 per cent of the whole, the rest made up of a series of natural cycles that will happen, with or without us.

We try to do better – to use less plastic, produce more sustainable food with fewer air miles. We all agree on this. Clean

up the oceans? Absolutely. Stop large conglomerates from rapaciously using the Earth’s free resources, sure. But hang on; is that actually happening? Not so much.

We the people are to be stopped from driving intercity and flying internationally; we are to be ghettoised into 15-minute cities. We were doing so well – recycling our waste, switching to what we thought was cleaner energy – and now this?

If we want to understand what large conglomerates have done and continue to do on Earth, we need look no further than the Union Carbide disaster at Bhopal in India – no one claims responsibility 50 years after the event. Now we find that the production of solar panels and mobile phones are a whole new environmental problem – lithium mining, slave labour, environmental unsustainability – but these are being sold to us as part of a ‘solution’.

Telecoms companies are poisoning our airwaves with 4G, 5G and beyond, and claiming they are not. Bird migration patterns are disrupted. The red kites which lived in my mother’s neighbourhood for decades disappeared overnight when a new phone mast was erected in her street. Everyone ignores that ecological disaster. Lest we forget: David Kelly’s death 20

years ago, lest we forget ‘45 minutes to doom’, the infamous headline in *The Sun* that ‘leaked’ the government’s ‘intelligence’ on Iraq’s weapons of mass destruction, from what became known as the ‘dodgy dossier’.

Kelly said to Gilligan that the government ‘sexed it up’ to make the case for war. His many visits to Iraq told him and his international colleagues that there were no weapons programmes of any consequence after twelve years of UN inspections and post-war privations imposed by NATO on Saddam Hussein.

The 2003 invasion of Iraq was a grab for the control of oil. We know that now. We can sit around dinner tables and nod sagely about how well we know all this... now. But that was then, right?

The Hutton Inquiry into Kelly’s death was a whitewash. A host of medical professionals wrote an open letter to the government at the time to say they could not in good conscience accept Hutton’s official verdict of suicide. It was medically impossible to die from a cut to the ulnar artery (Kelly allegedly used a tiny knife). The lack of blood found proved he didn’t die from bleeding out. The pills Kelly was supposed to have taken to hasten death required finding a significant amount of

them in his stomach. And 29 were missing from the blister packs he carried, but only half of one was found in his stomach. The pills would not have killed him had he taken them, i.e., 29 pills is not a fatal quantity anyway.

Still, it was suicide: an expert said so, and Hutton sealed the medical reports. The open letter by sceptical medical experts fell on the cloth ears of Tony Blair.

The man at the helm then is still appearing occasionally on television, an unquiet ghost, pushing the technocratic climate change agenda.

Do we think things got better over time? Has corruption been rooted out of government? No, corruption got away with it. That tells you everything you need to know. When you can get away with it, you carry on doing it. In the intervening 20 years, corruption, if anything, has found a firmer foothold.

So, why remember David Kelly? When a singular narrative is being told to us by every media and government voice, with all other theories being shut down, ridiculed, or misrepresented, be it weapons of mass destruction, or climate ‘boiling’, or a provably impossible suicide and yet reinforced every anniversary, that is when we must question it.

Growing revolution heating up

Change shopping habits to support British farmers

THE beginning of 2025 signifies the need to change our habits, all of us. We need to change our shopping habits and fast.

The corporatocracy aims to have us eating biomass insect foods produced in AI-controlled superfarms – that is after having killed all livestock with its net zero carbon agenda.

The current media frenzy over Bovaer (an additive that claims to reduce the amount of methane produced by cows) being added to cattle feed should not have us turning our backs on the dairy industry. This is playing directly into their hands. This is what they, the elite, want. We need to be cleverer than that. We need to boycott supermarkets and buy direct from the farmers and local organic product suppliers.

Having conducted some market research in the Wirral area, there appears to be interest in the concept of a home delivery service of organic farm produce and foods bought straight from the suppliers. Shoppers and consumers have become tired and weary of the additives, preservatives and chemicals in our foods.

The recent furore over Bovaer, and talk of eating insects and drinking milk made from algae has opened our eyes to what the food industry is doing. There is a growing clamour to change our shopping habits and to boycott supermarkets that sell poisons masquerading as food.

The problem is, given our hectic daily lives, supermarkets offer so much convenience with everything we need or want being sold under one roof. We have no option but to make organic farm produce and household supplies just as convenient to the masses. We, on the Wirral, are galvanising and organising and uniting to make this concept a reality.

There are 230,000 people living on the Wirral peninsula. If just 10 per cent of these wanted to boycott supermarkets and buy direct this would amount to 23,000 people. Some of those would be disabled and elderly or unable to drive, others will be working parents or single parents with little to no free time.

Others will be vegan, or vegetarian or doing keto diets. So, allowing for these people, and generously underestimating

Council turning blind eye?

Food shortages are very much expected this year. No one is coming to save us. We need to save ourselves. We cannot rely on our local councils. I have already tried alerting them.

Eighteen months ago, I sent every member of the Environment and Emergency Climate and Transport Committee at Wirral Council a notice of liability outlining the deliberately engineered food shortages. With that I included a copy of the publication *Challenging Net Zero With Science* by the Co2 Coalition and William Happer and Richard Lindzen as evidence backing up what I say. Every single councillor on that committee ignored me.

for the sake of prudence, let’s suppose just one per cent of these people are able to drive and shop direct for ALL goods from farms and suppliers - this amounts to 2,300 people making many more thousands of shopping trips per week.

This is insanity and a waste of time and fuel. So we are setting up a collection and delivery service for local people as a private members’ club. The total cost of fuel is divided between the number of customers on that delivery round

and then given to the driver. Time spent travelling is ‘paid’ by using a time-banking system. This ensures the scheme continues to operate as a not-for-profit service, run privately.

Our project is still very much in the early stages of development. We are sourcing seafood, fruit, vegetables, meat, baked goods, pulses and herbs, mushrooms, tinctures and herbal medicines, detergents and toiletries and firewood/coal from organic local suppliers.

It is anticipated that we will need to pre-order in advance for bulk purchases to allow these smaller businesses time to process such orders. Currently, we are waiting on price lists from local suppliers who want to be a part of this innovative project.

A form has been circulated to relevant local community groups on social media sites for people to complete. They simply provide their name and contact details, and mark which types of goods interest them, whether they prefer a home delivery service or a local collection point, and if they are interested in being one of the drivers, then simply email the form back to the administration team.

We are also seeking people with either £500 or £1,000 to invest in four acres of land on the Wirral. We aim to create a community allotment which will also operate as a private trust using the time-banking system.

The founding people involved in this are currently working on the trust deeds. We meet weekly and have a blitz team to help people prepare their gardens for growing food next season.

We share tips and ideas, seeds and produce, and all relevant information regarding the organic growing of food, using permaculture techniques.

The likes of Food Finders Hub, People’s Food and Farming Alliance and Crops Not Shops are part of a growing network that connects all those who need to eat.

We are at war over food. We win this war by shedding not one drop of blood but by uniting in compassion, care, empathy, love and supporting one another with our unique individual skills, knowledge and experience.

The farmers’ army is forming; this is a growing revolution. It is time to get our hands dirty and return to our roots.

Waking up the ill-informed

Questions to get the TV-programmed thinking

IN the deep, dark days of the covid scam, my global readership shot up massively, when I made a series of predictions about what we would see play out.

'Self-replicating' RNA jabs approved

LAST month, the EU's medicine committee recommended marketing authorisation of a new technology referred to as 'self-amplifying RNA vaccines' or 'replicon vaccines'.

Called Kostaive, it is reportedly for 'protection' against covid.

Infowars.com reported: 'The Committee for Medicinal Products for Human Use (CHMP) adopted a positive opinion, recommending the granting of a marketing authorisation for the medicinal product Kostaive, a vaccine intended for the prevention of covid-19 in adults.'

Kostaive is unlike the notorious mRNA gene therapy injections which make the vaccinated individual's body produce an antigen (the spike protein in the case of the covid shots).

The new saRNA vaccines go a step further, making the body replicate the replication mechanism itself. Traditional vaccines contain the antigen which is intended to elicit an immune response in the body, unlike mRNA vaccines which make the body

itself produce the antigen, which is then intended to elicit an immune response. Traditional vaccines also contain neurotoxins, such as aluminium as an adjuvant (to agitate the immune system

into action) and mercury as a preservative. Japan's medicines regulator had previously approved the first vaccine based on self-assembling RNA, which is designed to deliver greater efficacy with a lower dose. The Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare (MHLW) gave the green light to CSL and Arcturus' covid-19 vaccine ARCT-154, also known as Lunar-COV19, which will be commercialised in Japan by partner Meiji Seika Pharma. Japan was the first country to clear the saRNA vaccine.

It is claimed that the lipid nanoparticle-formulated shot, given in two doses 28 days apart, has been shown to be effective against multiple ancestral strains of SARS-CoV-2, the virus that caused covid-19. Phase 3 trials were reported to show more than 95 per cent efficacy in the prevention of severe covid infections.

SaRNA vaccines rely on RNA-dependent RNA polymerases (RDRP) derived from RNA viruses to amplify the delivered RNA, increasing the production of antigen proteins in the body.

Studies suggest the approach can improve the durability of protection, in part because it prolongs the stimulation of antigen-

presenting cells (APCs) important for long-term immunity.

CSL's Seqirus subsidiary bought into the ARCT-154 programme as part of a wide-ranging collaboration for saRNA vaccines spanning covid, influenza and other supposed respiratory infections, that included an upfront payment of \$200m and more than \$4bn in potential milestones. The bottom has largely dropped out of the market for covid vaccines, with the two top producers of mRNA-based shots – Pfizer/BioNTech and Moderna – both reporting lowered sales expectations.

‘If the roles were reversed’

Blistering attack on Israel’s genocide in Gaza

The Light makes no apologies for printing this account of the Gaza atrocities but does advise reader discretion as what the author describes below is graphic and upsetting

SUSAN Abulhawa’s blistering speech at the Oxford Union was the most ferocious indictment of Israel in the last decade.

Author Abulhawa – who is a long-term human rights activist – summarised the iniquitous history of the Jewish state in a few succinct paragraphs while shedding light on the obscene, toxic ideology that has permeated the nation’s doctrine from the very beginning.

Abulhawa ignored the fictitious claim that Israel was created to provide safety and security for the Jewish people and, instead, showed that the country’s founders were maniacally focused on seizing land while expelling or exterminating the indigenous population. Ethnic cleansing and land theft are not an unavoidable response to sporadic Palestinian violence, but the cornerstones of the pernicious dogma that animates the Zionist state. Needless to say, Abulhawa’s presentation was met with riotous applause that lasted for more than three minutes as the audience expressed their appreciation for her heartfelt testimony. Here’s part of what she said:

‘When I was in Gaza, I saw a little boy no more than nine years whose hands - and part of his face - had been blown off from a booby trapped can of food that soldiers had left behind for starving children.

I later learned that they had also left poisoned food for people in Shujaiyya, and in the 1980s and 90s Israeli soldiers left booby trapped toys in southern Lebanon that exploded when excited children picked them up.

The harm they do is diabolical and yet they expect you to believe they are the victims.

Invoking Europe’s holocaust and screaming antisemitism, they expect you to suspend fundamental human reason to believe that the daily sniping of children with so-called ‘kill shots’ and the bombing of entire neighbourhoods that bury families alive and wipe out whole bloodlines is self-defence.

They want you to believe that a man who had not eaten anything in over 72 hours, who kept fighting even when all he had was one functioning arm, was motivated by some innate savagery and irrational hatred or jealousy of Jews, rather than the

indomitable yearning to see his people free in their own homeland.

It’s clear to me that we’re not here to debate whether Israel is an apartheid or genocidal state. This debate is ultimately about the worth of Palestinian lives, about the worth of our schools, research centres, books, art, and dreams.

It’s about the worth of the homes we worked all our lives to build and which contain the memories of generations. It’s about the worth of our humanity, the worth of bodies and ambitions.

But what if the roles were reversed?

What if Palestinians had spent the last eight decades stealing Jewish homes, expelling, oppressing, imprisoning, poisoning, torturing, raping and killing?

What if Palestinians had killed an estimated 300,000 Jewish people in one year, targeted their journalists, their thinkers, their healthcare workers, their athletes, their artists?

What if they bombed every Israeli hospital, university, library, museum, cultural centre, synagogue, and simultaneously set up an observation platform where people could watch the slaughter as if a tourist attraction?

What if Palestinians had corralled hundreds of thousands into flimsy tents, bombed them in so-called safe zones,

burned them alive, cut off their food, water, and medicine?

What if Palestinians made Jewish children wander barefoot with empty pots; made them gather the flesh of their parents into plastic bags; made them bury their siblings, cousins and friends; made them sneak out from their tents in the middle of the night to sleep on their parents’ graves?

What if Palestinians made Jewish children pray for death just to join their families and not be alone in this terrible world that had terrorized them so utterly that they lose their hair, lose their memory, lose their minds?

What if Palestinians mercilessly forced babies to die, alone in hospital beds, crying until they could cry no more?

What if Palestinians used wheat flour aid trucks to lure the starving, then opening fire on them when they gathered to collect a day’s worth of bread?

What if Palestinians finally allowed a food delivery into a shelter, then set fire to the entire shelter and aid truck before anyone could taste the food?

What if a Palestinian sniper bragged about blowing out 42 Jewish kneecaps in one day as one Israeli soldier did in 2019?

What if a Palestinian admitted to CNN that he ran over hundreds of Jewish people

with his tank, with their squashed flesh lingering in the tank treads?

What if Palestinians were systematically raping Jewish doctors, patients, and other captives with hot metal rods, jagged and electrified sticks, sometimes raping to death, as reportedly happened with Dr Adnan al-Bursh and others?

What if Jewish women were forced to give birth in filth, get C-sections or leg amputations without anaesthesia?

What if the world were watching the live-streamed systematic annihilation of Jewish people in real time?

There would be no debating whether that constituted terrorism or genocide.

And yet two Palestinians — myself and Mohammad el-Kurd — have endured the indignity of debating with those who think our only life choices should be to leave our homeland, submit to Israeli supremacy, or die politely and quietly.

But you would be wrong to think that I came to convince you of anything. The house resolution, though well-meaning and appreciated, is of little consequence in the midst of this holocaust of our time.’

Holocaust that must be denied

Mainstream journalist blocked from using the H-word to describe Gaza atrocities

IT appears that professional journalists employed across the mainstream media are no longer able to live with the lack of editorial integrity in their coverage of Gaza.

The BBC, as a licence fee-funded organisation, with the most visited online news site in the world (last May alone it had 1.1 billion visits), is particularly culpable, but it seems no mainstream broadcaster is exempt from blame.

Many employees of these organisations have raised complaints through the appropriate channels but to no avail.

In November, a letter addressed to BBC Director-General, Tim Davie, signed by over 250 media industry professionals, including 101 anonymous BBC employees, accused the organisation of Israeli bias in its coverage of Gaza and called for:

- Accuracy across the board, including, but not limited to reiterating that Israel does not give external journalists access to Gaza.
- Making it clear when there is insufficient evidence to back up Israeli claims, and where Israel is the perpetrator in article headlines.
- Providing proportionate representation of experts in war crimes and crimes against humanity, including regular historical context predating October 2023.
- Use of consistent language when discussing both Israeli and Palestinian deaths, and robustly challenging Israeli government and military representatives in all interviews.

The consequences of unbalanced coverage are significant, as TV reports, articles and radio interviews fail to challenge Israeli claims adequately while dehumanising Palestinians in some cases.

Guardian columnist Owen Jones conducted an in-depth investigation into the BBC's coverage of Israel's 14-month assault on Gaza, during which he interviewed 13 BBC

journalists. Last month, he published his report on Drop Site News entitled *The BBC's Civil War Over Gaza*.

He describes the efforts made by reporters to address the betrayal of journalistic standards of impartiality and independence in the organisation's coverage of Gaza.

Jones further explains they were systematically stone-walled and gaslighted by management, to the point of being offered a telephone number of a BBC support group for mental health.

They name high-ranking BBC officials as being responsible.

Jones explains that anger had been building for weeks when in October, Rami Ruhayem, a Beirut-based BBC Arabic correspondent, sent an email to Tim Davie with a long list of examples he and his colleagues had been sharing regarding the biased and misleading framing of headlines and stories.

He highlighted the prominent use of words like 'massacre', 'slaughter' and 'atrocities' to refer to Hamas, seldom if ever used in relation to Israel's deliberate targeting of vast numbers of civilians.

He argued that when the BBC did mention Israel as a perpetrator, it used the caveat 'reportedly' in its headline, and repeated the Israel authorities' use of the word 'evacuate' to describe the forcible transfer of civilians – effectively using a euphemism for a war crime.

On December 5, Amnesty International published an extensive report concluding that Israel had committed, and was continuing to commit, a genocide.

The BBC's late and scant reporting of this came with the strapline: 'Israel rejects "fabricated" claims of genocide'.

The Guardian also faces embarrassment regarding journalists speaking out against the paper's oppressive censorship of reporting on Gaza.

Six staff writers at *The Guardian* spoke to Novara Media to explain that since October 7, 2023, the newspaper's editor-in-chief, Katherine Viner, has maintained a 'vice-like grip' over the paper's output on Israel and Palestine.

One senior staff member said: "Everything is scrutinised. You're under such suffocating control, it's like throwing sand in the gears [to] deliberately...frustrate the smooth running [of the paper]", adding that Viner's control was not exercised consistently - that it only applied when they were publishing something critical of Israel's actions in Gaza.

The newspaper's censorship takes the form of both suppressing Palestinian voices, as well as insidiously allowing other contributors to claim pieces reporting Israeli atrocities are a cover for 'new anti-semitism', or 'alibi anti-semitism'.

Editor-in-chief, Katherine Viner, has overruled section editors to withdraw two pieces by Palestinian contributors, Susan Adulhawa and Dylan Saba, that were commissioned by The Guardian US.

Rivkah Brown, commissioning editor of Novara Media, to whom The Guardian whistle-blowers spoke, claimed powerful Israel advocacy groups and media monitoring outfits have forced even the most prestigious publications on to the defensive.

They have done this by launching viral smear campaigns and by flooding editors' inboxes with complaints. Put simply, fear of offending the ubiquitous Israel Lobby determines how events are

presented, which opinions are allowed to be published, and how the narrative is shaped.

Adulhawa was invited by *The Guardian U.S.* to contribute to a series of opinion pieces on the global far right. She agreed, and submitted a short piece on Israel's genocide in Gaza. She is a widely respected Palestinian author whose debut novel, *Mornings in Jenin*, has sold over a million copies in 32 languages since its publication in 2006.

Edits of her piece went back and forth, which the author anticipated. Six weeks after she'd filed her piece, she received a final round of edits from *The Guardian*. She accepted most of them except the suggestion to change the word *holocaust* to *genocide*.

Adulhawa's draft said: 'Israel is committing the holocaust of our time, and it is doing it in full view of a seemingly indifferent world.'

The Guardian considered *holocaust* to be a 'verboden' word. Adulhawa's response was: "Given the magnitude, the unceasing horror, the hateful glee and sadism at our suffering, the only word I have at my disposal to capture what is happening in Gaza, is 'holocaust'. It is an English word, in the English Dictionary, and not the exclusive property of any group."

The piece was rejected.

Independent journalist, Jonathan Cook, accuses *The Guardian* and the establishment media of giving Israel licence to carry out a genocide in Gaza by falsely presenting it as a 'war with Hamas' as, until recently, there was an editorial ban on the use of the word *genocide*.

He said: "Israel's very rationale as a settler-colonial state is to eliminate and replace the native people through the three strategies of ethnic cleansing, apartheid, and genocide."

We are now reaching the final stage of the above process.

And the paper, whose original mission was to provide fearless, independent journalism, has instead succumbed to suffocating censorship.

Heart damage only in covid-jabbed

Not a single unvaccinated child among those suffering

A MAJOR study involving 1.7 million children has found that heart damage only appeared in children who had received covid mRNA vaccines.

Not a single unvaccinated child in the group suffered from heart-related problems.

In addition, the researchers note zero children from the entire group, vaccinated or unvaccinated, died from covid-19.

Furthermore, the study found that covid shots offered the children very little protection from the virus, with many becoming infected after just 14 to 15 weeks of receiving an injection.

The 1.7 million children observed in the study were between the ages of 5 to 15 and were registered with the UK's National Healthcare System (NHS).

The study was conducted by a team of leading UK medical doctors, epidemiologists, biostatisticians, and public health experts led by Oxford University's Professor. Colm D. Andrews.

A preprint of the study's paper was published in the MedRxiv medical journal.

The researchers were investigating the safety and effectiveness of Pfizer's vaccine in fully vaccinated, partially vaccinated, and unvaccinated children and teenagers.

However, they discovered that cases of myocarditis and pericarditis only emerged in the vaccinated group.

Zero cases of myocarditis or pericarditis were found in the unvaccinated group.

Myocarditis and pericarditis are both forms of inflammation in the heart.

Pericarditis is a condition where the sac around the heart becomes inflamed, while myocarditis is an inflammation of the heart muscle.

Both disorders restrict the heart's ability to pump blood around the body and can cause clots, strokes, heart attacks, cardiac arrest, and ultimately sudden death.

The study was launched due to the lack of safety information about the 'vaccines' that normally comes from clinical trials.

In the UK and the United States, public health agencies granted authorization to the Pfizer vaccines based on clinical trials that measured immunogenicity and efficacy against infection.

Immunogenicity is a measure of how well the vaccine elicits an immune response in the body.

The trials didn't test how well the vaccines protected against severe disease.

They also didn't assess particular safety endpoints, like myocarditis and pericarditis, which have been reported globally.

The UK study team, which also includes researchers from Harvard, created a hypothetical trial based on real-world observational data.

The researchers conducted their investigation using data from the NHS's OpenSAFELY-TTP database.

The database is part of the UK government's OpenSAFELY platform.

The secure platform allows researchers to access de-identified NHS data.

The database covers 40 per cent of English primary care practices.

It is linked to national coronavirus surveillance, hospital episodes, and death registry data.

The study included all children and adolescents in the database ages 5-15.

The data was analysed from August 31, 2021, when the vaccine was authorised in

the UK for that age group.

The group of data included over 1.7 million children.

Their research confirmed that covid mRNA 'vaccines' cause myocarditis and pericarditis, particularly in adolescents.

The research also confirmed that even in 2021, when the vaccine was first authorised for children and teens, that age group did not face a high risk for covid-19-related serious outcomes.

The disease did not put children at risk of death or the need for emergency care, hospitalization, or critical care.

Since then, that risk has become even lower.

However, the covid mRNA shots did create an unnecessary risk of heart disease in children.

Concerns are continuing to mount over the long-term impact of young or healthy people being pushed into taking dangerous vaccines for a virus that wasn't a threat to them.

As *Slay News* reported, another study has identified a shocking 500 per cent surge in deaths among children who have been given the mRNA shots.

The alarming study of 64,000 children and teenagers found that they are six times more likely to die after receiving a covid shot when compared to those unvaccinated.

The finding was buried in a study published earlier this year that identified covid shots as the cause of increasing cases of new-onset asthma in children.

Led by Professor Chiao-Yu Yang, the study was conducted by top researchers from Taiwan's Institute of Public Health and the Chung Shan Medical University Hospital in Taichung City.

The findings were published in the Springer Medical Journal.

In the conclusion section of the study's paper, the researchers wrote:

'The study highlights a strong link between covid-19 infection and an increased risk of new-onset asthma in children, which is even more marked in those vaccinated.'

Yet, buried deeper into the study it is revealed that those numbers refer to asthma or death.

While explaining the data on the 'incidence of new-onset asthma in the covid-19 and non-covid-19 groups,' the researchers wrote:

'4.7 per cent of covid-19-infected unvaccinated children developed new-onset asthma or death, compared to 2 per cent in their non-covid-19 counterparts within a year.

'For Cohort 2, covid-19-infected vaccinated children exhibited an 8.3 per cent incidence of new-onset asthma or death, which was higher than the 3.1 per cent observed in those who were not infected.'

The researchers show that 354 of the 64,000 children and teenagers who received a covid mRNA shot died within a year after vaccination – a death rate of almost six children per 1,000.

In contrast, only 309 out of 320,000 unvaccinated children died, fewer than one per 1,000.

Both the difference and the absolute death rates reported in the study are shockingly high.

Covid 'infections' themselves did not cause more deaths, the data shows.

Protecting rights to use cash

Banks' urgent warnings over the pitfalls of digital-only currency

IN a major U-turn in the international War on Cash, the government and central bank of Norway, one of Europe's most cashless economies, are seeking to slow or even reverse the mass abandonment of cash.

Only 3 per cent of Norwegians used cash in their latest purchase in a physical shop, according to a recent central bank survey.

In a bid to change that, a new amendment to Norway's Financial Contracts Act came into force on October 1 that bolsters citizens' rights to pay with cash in retail settings. The new legislation could sound the death knell for all the 'we only accept cards' signs plastered on shop windows throughout the country, reports the Norwegian online newspaper Nettavisen.

In recent years a growing number of countries in Europe have passed or proposed legislation to protect the right of citizens to use cash as payment. They include Switzerland and Austria, two countries where cash is still very much king, as well as Slovakia, where the Robert Fico government last year passed an amendment to the constitution intended to protect physical payments from a future in which the digital euro becomes mandatory.

Back in Sweden, which is arguably even more cashless than Norway, the Riksbank, like its Norwegian counterpart, has called on the government to adopt urgent measures to strengthen cash's role as a means of payment.

Late last year, the central bank echoed a point we have been making for the past few years: 'It is not enough to simply take measures to strengthen the availability of cash through withdrawal requirements and new depots, it must also be usable.'

That means taking a leaf out of neighbouring Norway's book and adopting legislation that makes it much harder for retail outlets to reject cash payments. In a 14-page response to a parliamentary inquiry on the State's role

in payments, the Riksbank warned that 'legislation on cash needs to be tightened up immediately' and 'political decisions are needed urgently so that everyone can pay.'

'Cash is essential for digitally and financially excluded consumers. Cash is also the only payment instrument that can be used independently of electricity and telecommunications and is therefore important for Sweden's emergency preparedness. There is no reason or time to wait for a new review, as the Inquiry infers. There is a considerable risk that cash will be further marginalised and that in the near future it can no longer be used for essential purchases. The Riksbank therefore proposes legislative amendments regarding the possibility of paying cash for essential goods and an obligation for banks to accept cash deposits from consumers.'

The Riksbank does not share the Inquiry's assessment that, with regard to legal tender, the legislator can wait to introduce even stronger obligations to accept cash until a new review of the status of cash and access to cash has been carried out. In the Riksbank's opinion, the inquiry should have submitted legislative proposals that strengthen the position of cash even more.

The inquiry itself concluded that Sweden's shift toward a cashless society may have finally reached the outer limits of what is possible — at least for the 'foreseeable future'.

'The use of cash for payment purposes has gradually declined over a longer

period of time and is now comparatively low,' the inquiry reported, before adding that demand for cash has 'remained virtually unchanged' over the past five years. 'Analysts have concluded that the direction of travel is clearly towards (in principle) a cashless society, especially in Sweden. The statistics, however, do not point to such a development, or indeed... that this will occur in the foreseeable future.'

Now, the central banks of both Sweden and Norway have the unenviable task of trying to slow or even reverse the mass abandonment of cash that they themselves helped set in motion. They will have their work cut out given that so much of their respective countries' cash infrastructure — in particular private banks' branch networks, ATMs and the distribution services offered by cash handling companies — has been allowed to wither over recent years.

It also remains to be seen whether enough Swedish and Norwegian citizens are prepared to re-embrace cash if it is made more available and easier to use. As in many countries, demand for cash in Norway has risen slightly over the past year with the number of withdrawals at ATMs ticking up, according to Norges Bank. But is this a sustainable trend? As payment technologies have advanced this century, most Norwegian and Swedish citizens have embraced the speed, ease and convenience of digital payments. But they were also nudged in that direction.

By 2016, Sweden's commercial banks had made 60% of their branches cashless, as a 2019 Riksbank working

paper documents. This made it much more difficult for citizens to access cash and for businesses to deposit it, which in turn accelerated the uptake of digital payments and the abandonment of cash. The Riksbank did its part by withdrawing many of Sweden's large denomination notes from circulation. Now, it is trying to halt, or at least slow, the country's onward march toward a cashless future.

Time is of the essence. As the central bank warns, if urgent action isn't taken to fortify Sweden's cash infrastructure, it will soon be too late:

[T]here are already such problems with cash and cash handling that there is reason to immediately tighten legislation to safeguard the position of cash and access to cash services. If the state waits until cash and cash services are further phased out, this could lead to a situation where it is too late to take action, or there is a risk that operators will be forced to go back and reinvest in equipment and systems.

Given Norway and Sweden have gone further than most countries in removing cash from the economy, the fact they are both now warning about the dangers and vulnerabilities of a fully cashless economy as well as the urgent need to protect both access to and use of cash should be taken very seriously — not just within their borders but far beyond them.

Feminine and masculine energy

Challenge of being trans in the freedom movement

AROUND the time I joined the freedom movement to oppose covid tyranny, the media agenda was gripped by a sudden obsession with transpeople.

Has there ever been a more blatant or successful divide and rule ploy? I was sad to see freedom comrades obsessing over how others choose to look, dress, relate to others and enjoy their bodily autonomy and medical freedom. These are surely personal matters and no-one else's business.

What IS gender? And what is biological sex?

Sex is simple. For most, it's chromosomes determining if you get a willy or not.

Gender is a little more complex. It's a function of an individual's yin-yang (feminine or masculine) personal energy balance and also a 'social construct' - how an individual is expected (or compelled) to behave in society (e.g., 'boys don't cry or wear pink'). Our individual energy balances may sit on a spectrum between masculine or feminine or change fluidly over time.

History and everyday experience show us that it's fairly common for someone's gender to be at odds with their biological sex. Some describe this as 'being born into the wrong body', yet I'm uncomfortable suggesting that incarnation may err.

Say rather that this undeniable facet of human nature doesn't fit well into mass-managed hierarchical societies, especially those with warlike traditions. Hierarchy emerged via competitive male struggle so until recently males were viewed (by other males, of course) as of higher status.

Thus tomboys may have won acceptance yet a feminine male was regarded as somehow shameful or improper. This may be why transwomen greatly outnumber transmen. The fortunate may have found relationships and roles in society suited to a gentle, heart-centred nature. Others would be despised as weak or effeminate, fearing persecution and perhaps seeking solace in secretive gay relationships. Yet others struggled on in misery, constantly compelled by society to 'man up' and act like good little soldiers. My life was like this until recently.

Gender 101

Gender Binary:
The categorization of gender into two distinct, opposite sexes.



Trans/Transgender:
An umbrella term applied to those whose gender identity is not the same as the sex they were assigned at birth.



Cisgender:
Someone who identifies exclusively as their sex assigned at birth.



Genderqueer:
A term applied to individuals who do not identify within the gender binary.



Transition:
The process of changing one's gender expression to match their gender identity.



A wise friend once taught me of the Jungian anima and animus, the masculine and feminine energies and from then I knew myself to be Katie – of essentially feminine nature – yet for decades, having being born biologically male, there seemed no way to live more authentically. Last year, my father died. He was kindly but slightly autistic, with a 1950s worldview and prejudices set in stone. He didn't hate gender non-conforming people, the concept simply didn't compute.

Looking through old family photos, I was transfixed by one of myself in my early 20s with long, beautiful hair and delicate facial features. Something crystallised and I realised: I'm transgender! And that's a thing now!

Over months, I gradually feminised my look and let friends and colleagues know that I am Katie. Rather than demanding that the world revolve around my life-journey, my approach has been to gradually win acceptance through love,

patience and kindness.

A freedom comrade joked 'we don't mind you transitioning, just don't go woke'. Though sometimes doctrinaire, trans activists have done important work gaining us rights and recognition. The distorting lens of the media shows only extremists, precisely as the freedom and 'anti-vax' movements are portrayed by the same media as lunatic far-right conspiracy theorists.

Divide and rule relies on polarising perspectives to 'harden the sides and squeeze out the middle', thus we are shown bitter ideological warfare between biological-sex supremacists and gender supremacists in angry irreconcilable opposition – with actual transpeople as political footballs in the middle, demonised by the Right and corralled into victimhood by the Left. Ugh. No. We just want to live our lives.

In some contexts, biological sex matters. Biological males average physically stronger so failed male athletes may

sometimes cynically 'transition on paper' to gain advantage – yet individuals abusing sporting categories should not reflect on other transpeople.

Spaces like toilets and changing rooms can be awkward, yet unisex facilities are very often available. Where not, common sense and kindness usually avail. I once needed the loo in a busy pub. My presentation was then still ambiguous so I didn't use the ladies. As I approached the gents a guy called out 'wrong one love!'.

I smiled awkwardly. He realised. We both laughed and I darted nimbly to a cubicle.

Lurid media tropes of transwomen scaring other women in changing rooms forget there are norms in male spaces too. Again, individual unwellness or failures of common sense and empathy should not reflect on other transpeople.

Some darkly mutter about 'trans ideology being pushed in schools', forgetting that ideological indoctrination is mostly what state schools do by design. For the free thinker and free of heart insisting upon ANY rigid ideology or dogma indicates a failure of imagination and empathy, especially where there is entrenched division. Indoctrination closes hearts and minds and is inimical to true education which should teach us to open them. A sympathetic understanding of gender IS necessary for all children to grow up with the freedom which arises from self-knowledge.

Fears that children in the UK are being pushed towards hormones or surgery are unfounded. There is currently a blanket ban in the UK on hormone prescriptions for under-18s, and each year, a few hundred adults who have already socially transitioned receive these treatments on the NHS. In this context, the anti-trans movement looks like a pointless exercise in fashion policing driven by contrived moral panic. A deliberate distraction from real issues like the unfolding world war and the coming currency crises, among others.

'What is a woman?' Nowadays, this political 'gotcha' question brings only tub-thumping over competing definitions. 'What does it mean to be of a masculine or feminine energy?' Open exploration of this more useful question helps us all to understand our natures and thus how to build societies in which we are each and all free to dwell and thrive together peacefully.

Preparing for uncertain future

Elderly can share a wealth of knowledge on survival skills

I AM old, for a warrior. It's harder to get about, to keep warm, to go out and be social.

However, in recent years I've come to see that this battle is not only for the young, and we elders have a critical part to play in the making of the future.

We are, or can be, walking libraries of skills and traditions that do not rely on computers or any sophisticated technology to continue working at making our lives nourishing, comfortable, healthy.

For millennia, humans in general were multi-skilled and lived much more comfortably than philosopher Thomas Hobbes' 'nasty, brutish, mean and short-lived' description would suggest.

In the British Isles, for example, peasants

had a hundred holy days a year, most of which were non-working days. Many had their own cow, pig, sheep and poultry which grazed on the common and were taken indoors into lean-tos to keep themselves and the cottage warm in winter. They had land, in many social arrangements, enough to grow their own food, and no settlement would be built where there was not clean, potable water nearby.

We all grew up on scare stories about how horrible the 'Dark Ages' were, and it has become apparent in the last few decades that this simply isn't a true picture, or at least not a universal one.

Fernand Braudel, who wrote compelling books on European history, details unexpectedly rich information about lives before us, showing how inaccurate the standard meme of cruel landlords and oppressed peasants was.

And a walk around any ancient churchyard will demonstrate a large proportion of lives lost very young to disease, later to childbirth but also a good proportion of lives ending in the 70s or even 80s; also that the extended family was fully

functional in villages where, without travel, people lived with their sisters and brothers and many relations.

One Cornish family, when their tin mine was closed, moved en masse up to the black country to continue working mines. That shows that freedom of movement as well as strong family bonds could be enjoyed by even humble cottagers.

So here I am, old now, in the ancient Forest of Dean. I live almost off-grid, on almost no money. I grow food and preserve it, spin, dye and weave clothing, and have for almost fifty years been a practising homeopath, so I can help people throw off a huge range of illnesses and disorders, both physical and mental.

I would say I am wealthy. I have friends and family, a good social network, keep busy daily, whether dyeing or chopping firewood. But most of all, I teach. I have nearly all the skills of a medieval country housewife, and as well as training homeopaths – which we are shortly going to need very much – I have 'at home' days where I carry on my normal life, and share it with eager visitors.

We make our own bread, and butter, and cheese, gather food from the garden for

soup and salad, and firewood to stay warm. We make basic herbal medicines, such as creams and cough mixtures, and then do some spinning or other crafts, whether it be sewing or preserving, spoon carving or making paper. All good fun, a merry middle-class day out for the prosperous – or is it?

These are mostly survival skills. Can you preserve eggs in summer to keep all winter? Do you know how to make pickles? Can you make a beautiful, durable woollen winter garment for when the electricity goes off?

We are living through the end of a civilisation. Although we don't know what is going to happen, it's quite clear that those who grow food will eat, those who make clothes will be warm, those who know domestic medicine have the best chance of being healthy.

People like me, who live like this, are mostly old now, but we still have the knowledge. We need to share it, you younger ones need to learn it. How can we make this happen?

Why not think about learning the old skills, and then teaching other people? It's something you will never, ever regret.

Rhine meadows killing fields

The murder, rape and plunder of Germany post-WW2

Germany's defeat in May 1945 and the end of World War II in Europe did not bring an end to death and suffering for the already vanquished German people.

Instead, the victorious Allies ushered in a terrible new era of destruction, looting, starvation, rape, 'ethnic cleansing' and mass killing.

A recent edition of Time magazine referred to this period as 'history's most terrifying peace'.

The thoroughly devastated German Reich was systematically raped and robbed and many Germans who survived the war were either killed in cold blood or deliberately left to die of disease, cold, malnutrition and starvation.

Some three million Germans died unnecessarily after the official end of hostilities – about two million civilians, mostly women, children and elderly and about one million prisoners of war in the Rhine Meadows camps.

British and American authorities denied International Red Cross representatives

access to camps holding German prisoners of war. Moreover, any attempt by German civilians to feed the prisoners was punishable by death.

Many thousands of German POWs died in American custody, most infamously in the 'Rhine Meadows Camps', where prisoners were held under appalling conditions, with no shelter or sanitation and totally inadequate food.

In April 1946, the International Committee of the Red Cross protested that the U.S., Britain and France were violating Red Cross agreements they had solemnly pledged to uphold. They also claimed the American transfer of German prisoners of war to French and British authorities for forced labour was contrary to International Red Cross statutes.

For two years after the end of the fighting, the Germans were victims of a cruel and vindictive occupation policy, one that meant a deliberate starvation of the remaining population.

In a letter published in a London newspaper in October 1945, Bertrand Russell, the noted philosopher and Nobel Prize recipient, wrote: 'In eastern Europe now, mass deportations are being carried out by our allies on an unprecedented scale.

'It is an apparently deliberate attempt being made to exterminate many millions of Germans by

depriving them of their homes and of food, leaving them to die by slow and agonizing starvation. This is not done as an act of war but as a part of a deliberate policy of "peace".

We are ceaselessly reminded, by the thousands of books and documentaries now being produced, of the Third Reich's wartime concentration camps, but few are aware that such infamous camps as Dachau, Buchenwald, Sachsenhausen and Auschwitz were kept in operation after the end of the war, only now packed with German citizens, many of whom also perished miserably and unnecessarily.

In the war's aftermath, the victors put many German military and political leaders to death or sentenced them to lengthy prison terms after the much-publicised Nuremberg trials in which the Allies were both prosecutor and judge.

Justice, as opposed to vengeance, is a standard that is assumed to be applied impartially but

in the aftermath of World War Two, the victorious powers imposed standards of justice that applied only to the vanquished. The governments of the U.S., Britain and the USSR held Germans to a standard that they categorically refused to respect themselves.

Germans were executed or imprisoned for policies that the Allies themselves used, sometimes on a far greater scale. German military and political leaders were executed on the basis of a hypocritical double standard, which meant that these executions were essentially acts of legalised murder. Had the standards of the Nuremberg Tribunal been applied impartially, many American, British, Soviet and other Allied leaders would also have been hanged.

History, as the saying goes, is written by the victors. In our society, the victors, the most important single group that sets our perspective on the past through its grip on the media, and

on our cultural life, is the organised Elite community.

According to the testimony of a former infantryman, in late March or early April, 1945, he was sent to guard a camp of German military and civilian prisoners near Andernach on the River Rhine, one of the many infamous Rhine Meadows camps.

In Andernach, about 50,000 prisoners of all ages and sexes were held in an open field surrounded by barbed wire. They had no shelter and no blankets and most had no coats. They slept in the mud, wet and cold, with inadequate slit trenches for use as toilets. It was the coldest, wettest spring of that century and their misery from exposure alone was evident.

Outraged, he protested to the officers and was met with hostility or sheer indifference. When pressed, they explained they were under strict orders from above.

Realising that his protests

were futile, he asked a friend working in the kitchen if he could smuggle out any extra food for the prisoners. But when he threw this food over the barbed wire to the prisoners, he was caught and threatened with imprisonment.

It is hard to escape the conclusion that General Dwight D Eisenhower was a war criminal of epic proportions.

Eventually, famine began to spread among the German civilians also. It was a common sight to see German women looking in bins looking for something edible. There was no Red Cross presence at the camps or helping civilians.

"So what?" some may say, "the enemy's atrocities were worse than ours." It is true that the German opportunity for atrocities had ended, but two wrongs do not make a right.

Rather than mimicking an enemy's crimes, should we not aim to break the cycle of hatred and vengeance that has always plagued and distorted human history?

However, we can reject propaganda that depicts our enemies as subhuman and encourages these kinds of outrages. And we can also protest the bombing of civilian targets and refuse to condone our government's murder and torture of unarmed prisoners of war and helpless civilians.

In October 2022, I was admitted to Royal Blackburn Teaching Hospital in Rossendale, Lancashire and diagnosed with a lower respiratory infection. I have never had any covid jabs and when asked to have the test, I refused.

banking cartel, no funding arrived and up popped the EDL as a splinter group headed by Tommy Robinson (real name Stephen Yaxley-Lennon).

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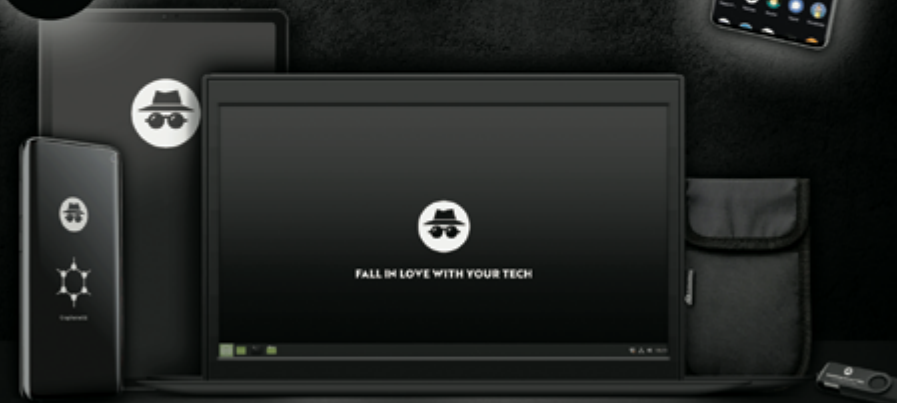


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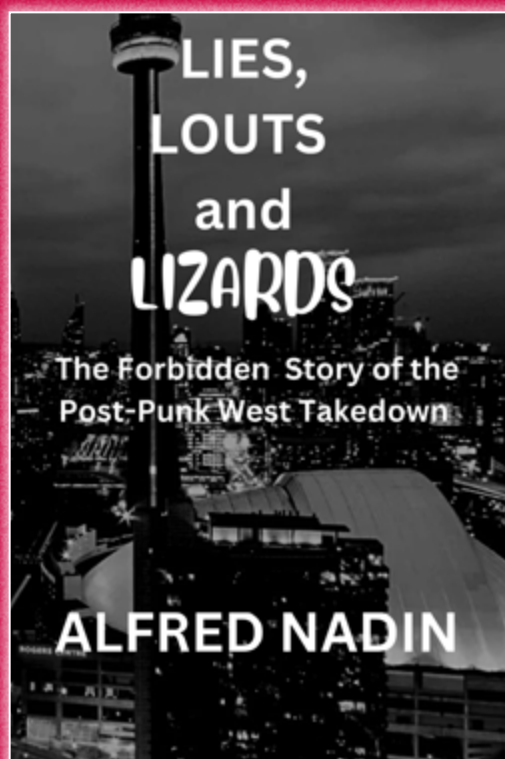
