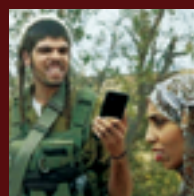

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Cut out the middle man

Hundreds of millions are already participating in a new economy

THE money system is failing. Not because of duplicitous bankers or compromised politicians — though there is no shortage of either — but because of three structural flaws baked in from the start; it concentrates power upward by design, it encloses what belongs to everyone, and it runs on debt that must grow perpetually to service itself. That mathematics has no good ending.

But while the old order strains and lurches, something else has been quietly demonstrating what comes next — inside the very platforms built to extract value from human activity.

Google has shared more than \$100 billion with content creators over the last four years alone. Amazon hosts millions of small producers, traders and makers. Facebook groups pulse with local skill-

sharing, mutual aid and problem-solving. People are exchanging knowledge, experience and solutions at worldwide scale, across distances and between strangers, without prior agreement and often without money changing hands at all.

Nobody planned this. It emerged because human beings, given a surface to collaborate on, collaborate. The platforms captured the value — that is their business model — but they could not capture the impulse itself. What Big Tech — Google, Amazon, Facebook, Apple and Microsoft — accidentally proved is that distributed contribution and access works. The infrastructure of a different kind of economy has been operating inside the belly of the incumbent one for decades.

This is not a small observation. It is the proof of concept the transition has been waiting for.

The question was never whether people

would share, contribute and organise without being compelled by scarcity. They always have. The question was whether it could work at scale.

It can. It does. We have watched it happen.

The platforms are not the destination. They route everything back through the monetary extraction layer — attention harvested, data enclosed, value skimmed at every transaction. Big Tech operates on fear-adjacent motivations: status, monetisation, algorithmic approval. The behaviour it hosts is generous; the architecture that contains it is not.

This is the structural irony at the heart of the current moment. The most extractive platforms in history have simultaneously demonstrated that the alternative works, while remaining constitutionally incapable of completing the transition. They are, in the language of the old system, too invested in the problem to be part of the solution.

What is needed is not a better platform. It is a coordination layer that does what Big Tech does — connecting contribution to access, recognising value, enabling exchange across distance and between strangers — without routing through the institutionalised hierarchy that created the problem. Without the enclosure. Without the debt. Without the extraction. That is what the Contribution Access Network proposes.

The transition from one system to another rarely looks like revolution. It looks like the internet in 1995 — most commerce still happening by post and telephone, the new thing existing alongside the old, quietly making the old look clunkier by comparison, until one day it was simply how things worked. Nobody stormed a citadel. The centre of gravity moved.

Linux didn't petition Microsoft. It became undeniable. Linux now does the heavy lifting throughout the world's information infrastructure.

What is shifting now is deeper than technology. Technology is trivial — the infrastructure for direct value handling already exists. What is shifting is the organising principle itself: from scarcity to sufficiency, from competition to contribution, from fear to something that, without making too much of the word, resembles love.

Fear-based organisation is what the incumbent system runs on. Debt is fear made structural — the perpetual anxiety

of what happens if you cannot service it. Enclosure is fear made territorial — the conversion of commons into property, abundance into scarcity, gift into transaction. Institutionalised hierarchy is fear made permanent — authority encoded, enforced, insulated from the feedback of those it governs.

The web of direct value exchange that is already growing at the edges operates on a different logic entirely. The neighbour who fixes your car in exchange for help with his garden is not calculating return on investment. The parent who teaches twenty children music because she loves it, and whose own children get swimming lessons from someone who loves that, is not managing risk. The community repair café, the local food-sharing group, the open source project maintained by volunteers across a dozen countries — none of these are fear-based. They persist because the people in them find meaning in the contribution itself.

This is not nostalgia for a simpler time. It is a description of what is already happening, at scale, right now.

The transition accelerates not when enough people are persuaded by the argument. It accelerates when experience of the alternative makes the argument unnecessary — when the doing and the understanding evolve together, as they always have in genuine learning.

Big Tech, for all its contradictions, has been an unwitting teacher. It has shown hundreds of millions of people that sharing knowledge costs nothing and creates abundance. That problems posted openly attract solutions from unexpected directions. That contribution without prior agreement is not chaos — it is, in fact, how human beings organise when the compulsion of scarcity is removed.

The next step is not a giant leap. It is the same impulse, freed from the extraction layer. Contribution recognised. Access enabled. Value flowing directly between those who create it and those who need it, without the toll booth in the middle.

That point is closer than most people think. The proof was always there.

Death by cruise ship

Deep dive into high mortality statistics around holidays at sea

WHILE glossy brochures promise paradise on the high seas – endless buffets, sunset cocktails and once-in-a-lifetime adventures – a grimmer reality lurks beneath the surface.

Every year, hundreds of passengers and crew members never make it home from their dream cruise. Ships even carry onboard morgues. Because death at sea isn't the exception – it's quietly becoming part of the package.

Official figures suggest that there are around 200 cruise ship deaths per year across the industry, with roughly 30 million passengers setting sail annually in normal times. That works out to about one death for every 150,000 guests - or three to four per week. But as with so many things in this tightly controlled industry, the true number is almost certainly higher. Reporting is patchy at best, due mainly to a distinct lack of central oversight.

Most of the deaths are chalked up to 'natural causes' – heart attacks, strokes and other medical emergencies generally striking older passengers. Because the average cruiser is usually getting on a bit. Many are retirees ticking off that bucket-list trip, sometimes while managing serious health conditions. But is that the whole story? Or are we seeing a pattern that mainstream outlets prefer to gloss over?

Beyond natural causes, other incidents continue to raise eyebrows. Falls overboard remain disturbingly common – around 19-25 cases a year globally. Some are ruled accidents, linked to alcohol or unsecured barriers. Others leave families with unanswered questions.

Suicides, murders and mysterious disappearances also feature in the grim statistics. A detailed 2000-2019 analysis of 623 reported deaths found falls, cardiac events and intentional acts among the leading causes for passengers.

Records are kept – sort of. Ships log incidents, and vessels heading to U.S. ports must notify authorities. But there is no comprehensive global database. Investigative sites and academics piece

together what they can from news reports and sparse official releases. Transparency? Not exactly a priority when profits are sailing high.

Just this month, as most of the world knows, the MV Hondius made headlines after three passengers died amid an alleged hantavirus outbreak during a polar expedition cruise.

The Dutch-flagged ship, carrying people from multiple countries, remained under strict protocols off of Cape Verde as investigations continued. The story pushed by mainstream media is this: while hantavirus is rare on cruise ships, it serves as a stark reminder of how quickly things can turn deadly in a confined, floating environment.

Flash back to 2020, and the nightmare on Princess Cruises vessels during an early 'covid' outbreak. The Diamond Princess became infamous: over 700 infections and at least 13 deaths (with some reports citing 14).

The Ruby Princess saw 28 associated deaths and hundreds of cases, later leading to a successful class-action lawsuit against the operators for alleged negligence. The story was that

these floating petri dishes exposed vulnerabilities that authorities were slow to address – or, critics argued, actively downplayed.

Time and again, we see the same issues: delayed responses, incomplete information for passengers, and a rush to protect the industry's image. Older travellers, often the backbone of the cruise market, bear the brunt.

Cruise lines are always quick to point out that per-passenger risk remains low compared to everyday life on land. Ships have medical facilities and procedures in place.

But when you pack thousands of, frequently elderly, people together for days on end – with buffets, excursions and shared air – vulnerabilities multiply. Add alcohol, adventure activities and the sheer isolation of being hundreds of miles from proper hospitals, and the risks become clear.

Are these deaths just the price of fun in the sun? Or does the industry's 'what happens at sea stays at sea' attitude leave grieving families in the dark? As more people – including those with underlying conditions seeking that final big trip –

board these vessels, questions about safety, disclosure and accountability demand answers.

Consume, work, behave

China surveillance state ‘like online multiplayer game’

RATHER than the clatter of jackboots, the 21st century great reset has thus far been more about propagating acceptance and encouraging willingness to ‘do the right thing’.

Some have described this as ‘5th generation warfare’, where the control of institutions, locked-down media coverage, and the pervasiveness of technological device-use has clearly evidenced the effectiveness of ‘soft power’ over military might.

Any chinks in the armour of this programme have been repaired through the deployment of controlled opposition, and funded campaigns to discredit, smear, or deplatform dissenters. If all else fails, the ‘unexpected death’ of many who have been willing to stand up and defy the forces of oppression is always an option.

The ongoing docility of the majority will clearly present no major obstacles to continuation of the billionaire-tech elite reset.

And there now looms a more complex agenda that will crank things up a notch.

Larry Ellison, co-founder of the Oracle Corporation software company, has openly signposted such a move, arguing that ‘the wonders of AI will bring about a new paradigm of surveillance guaranteeing that everyone will always need to be on their best behaviour.’

The system innovations that have been developed in tandem with ‘sustainable development’ (and funded by the same architects) are now very close to reaching a point where Ellison’s prophecy is fulfilled.

The Epstein class’s clear use of occultism and ritual symbology means that they must tell you first what they are doing, wait for the reaction (if there is one), and then continue with their plans.

Ellison’s admission that we will be forced to behave sometime soon is a perfect example. These people believe that they are untouchable, and there are many examples which mirror Ellison’s brazen statement.

This arrogance is helped of course because the masses remain largely in a trance state and continue to do as they are told without being aware – or not wanting to know – that they are being ushered into digital slavery.

Those who are concerned point to China. Indeed, tech pioneer Gary Johnson has said: “China’s social credit system represents the most comprehensive attempt to create a scored society where every citizen’s behaviour is monitored, evaluated, and ranked according to algorithmic criteria.”

While China is held up as the destination to which we are headed – and of course it certainly offers us some idea of what is to come – Johnson reasons that it is a different form of control than the tracks that are currently being laid for us in the West.

Johnson likens the system in China to ‘a massive multiplayer online game’ with an estimated 200 million Chinese citizens having been affected by social credit score restrictions, impacting their lives in various ways. And they have all been made aware of the rules of the game.

As he points out: “Chinese citizens understand roughly how they are being evaluated.” This enables a certain element of being able to ‘game the system’ for those who choose to do so.

For example, a late utility bill payment (and an affected credit score) can be cancelled out by what the state deems to be a ‘positive contribution’ such as undertaking voluntary work in the community or by partaking in some other government-approved endeavour.

In this system, the behavioural modification element of

the system is designed to augment a ‘carrot and stick’ approach – comprehending how the system operates and understanding how to adapt to it. All of course, in favour of what the state requires of its citizens.

However you want to view this variant of social engineering, it is still authoritarianism – just another flavour of tyranny aligned to different human motivations. The point made by Johnson, however, is that while we have been pointing to ‘algorithmic citizenship’ in China as something we need to avoid at all costs, the rulers have been busy building a much more sinister and multi-layered system in the West.

What we have ahead is something that will be markedly more top down, opaque in design, and much more difficult to navigate for those on the receiving end.

The tech giants in Silicon Valley – demonstrated particularly in Peter Thiel’s Palantir, and its Goliath offshoot – now has software capabilities that are fast becoming game-changers in surveillance operations.

They enable governments, military bodies, health agencies, large corporations and businesses to mine, integrate and analyse huge volumes of data that will actively support enforcement of our future behaviour.

This will be aligned with predictive policing.

Palantir has lucrative contracts in place worldwide (both current and planned) across a range of institutions, organisations and interests, all of which will deploy a more tightly scripted state-of-the-art police state.

We won’t be told the rules of this game. Social nudging and cultural engineering will have been long consigned to the annals of history by the time we come face to face with this complete surveillance/control infrastructure.

It will be complemented by three things: 15-minute cities, central bank digital currency, and digital ID.

This ‘triple lock’ system is now being snuck in under the radar while we are being distracted by scare stories in the media.

China’s social credit system is overseen by the government and, theoretically at least, offers a degree of transparency.

But corporations like Palantir will operate according to their own rules, meaning that credit scores, insurance risk assessments, employment screening, rental application systems and consumer profiling will be overseen by invisible algorithmic judgement you won’t know anything about.

Schooled in obedience

State education the trap ensuring slavery for future generations

THE system rewards compliance and we learn this early.

The underlying code for the system we inhabit is not progress, nor is it public safety – the code is control.

We are living through a meticulously engineered reality where every layer of society is built upon a foundation designed to monitor, manage and manipulate the human spirit.

From the levers of governance to the mechanisms of social interaction, the primary objective is to ensure that accountability remains a foreign concept to those who pull the strings – while the rest of society is funneled into a state of perpetual obedience.

This is not a series of unfortunate accidents or a byproduct of bureaucratic inefficiency. It is a planned, well-funded and ruthlessly enforced structure designed to prioritise the powerful at the expense of individual sovereignty.

The genius of this system lies in its ability to decouple action from consequence. When an environment is constructed where an individual believes they can be personally enriched by causing harm – while simultaneously being shielded from any personal liability – a certain subset of humanity will execute that harm on command. This isn't merely a dark theory, it is a scientifically demonstrated reality of the human psyche.

The Milgram experiment famously illustrated this fragility. When placed under the direction of a perceived authority figure and assured that they would not be held responsible for the damage inflicted, ordinary people were willing to continue delivering what they believed were lethal electric shocks to another human being.

The system uses this exact blueprint. It positions influential people into seats of power through bribery and brokering, knowing that they will do the bidding of their masters without a single concern for the wreckage they leave behind.

To maintain this grid, the system requires a specific kind of human 'work product': the weak. Over the last century, there has been a systematic erosion of the attributes that would naturally resist a tyrannical control structure.

We have seen a constant, deliberate leaching of physical resilience, mental

fortitude and moral clarity from the Western population. A moral people is a dangerous people to a corrupt system, and so morality has been replaced by an easily manipulated mindset that values comfort over character.

The most effective way to ensure lifelong obedience is to capture the mind before it has the chance to develop its own defences. To achieve this, the state has positioned itself as the ultimate parental figure, effectively 'disappearing' the traditional role of the parent step by step.

It begins with the normalisation of state-run childcare. Parents are told that children should enter pre-kindergarten and kindergarten as early as possible. Under the guise of providing a 'free service', the state offers what is essentially a babysitting operation staffed by state-trained individuals who are inherently pro-state.

While parents are off working menial, minimum-wage jobs just to keep a roof over their heads, the state is spending the child's most formative waking hours training them.

In this exchange, the family lineage and the transmission of survival skills are sacrificed for the convenience

of the system.

In the government school system, the rewards are not for the brilliant, the creative, or the innovative; the rewards are strictly for the obedient. Creativity is often punished because it introduces contrast and unpredictability – two things a control grid cannot tolerate.

The work product of this schooling is a class of obedient bureaucrats and workers who will fill the desks of government and corporate offices without ever questioning the validity of their tasks.

To keep this servant class invested, the system creates a mythology of 'experts' and false 'idols'. We are taught to idolise those who stayed within the lines, received their accolades, and applied their discipline to fields often built on layers of fraud.

These fields – such as virology, space travel, and nuclear physics – deal with subjects that most people cannot verify with their five senses. Because these topics exist at scales too small or distances too great to experience directly, they become 'imagination fields' where fraud can be perpetuated indefinitely.

By layering theory upon unproven theory, the system replaces God with scientism and the parent with the state. It creates a reality where 'truth' is whatever the expert says it is, and the individual is reduced to a surrogate for the system's ideology.

The state maintains its grip through the claimed 'legitimate' use of lethal force. It tells the lie that it is 'of the people, by the people, and for the people' to justify military violence abroad and police violence at home.

But this is a facade designed to protect the powerful and maintain the status quo. The court system, the university system and the government all work in lockstep to ensure there is no contrast – because contrast leads to realisation, and realisation leads to freedom.

There is, however, an alternative that the system does everything in its power to make invisible. Thinkers like Lysander Spooner argued over a century ago that man has a birthright from God to be fully autonomous.

Sovereignty means having the right to make choices, even if those choices result in self-harm. If an individual is the only one being harmed by their 'vices', no government has the right to interfere. The moment we allow the state to regulate personal behaviour under the guise of 'helping' us, we give them the excuse to regulate all behaviour until everything becomes illegal.

True order is found in Natural Law, which is refreshingly simple: harm no one, harm no one's property, and honour your word. As long as you are not violating these three principles, you should be left alone. The state, however, rejects this simplicity because it cannot monetise or control it. Instead, it offers a 'devil's bargain': it will provide food, water and shelter, provided you surrender your independence, your critical thinking and your sovereignty.

Most people have no idea they have the option to step out of this system. They have been taught to fear freedom and to reflexively reject the idea of their own autonomy. They are told that the state is their protector, when in reality, the state is their master.

The grid of control is vast and deeply entrenched but it relies entirely on our continued obedience. Until we recognise the design of our own indoctrination, we will remain cogs in a machine that is programmed to consume us.

Nothing to kill or die for

In the absence of enemies, the state will create one

BACK in 2010, author and *Guardian* columnist, Sir Simon Jenkins, published an article arguing for the defence budget to be completely scrapped. 'I don't mean nibble at it or slice it,' he wrote, 'I mean cut it, all £45bn of it.'

It was in response to the then Chancellor, George Osborne asking the public what superfluous government spending could be reasonably eliminated that would represent a significant saving, given the straitened position of the Treasury following the 2008/9 financial crisis. Jenkins reminded us that at the end of the Cold War in the 1990s, there was much talk of a peace dividend, but that this sent the defence industry into a frenzied search for new hobgoblins with which to create "a fantasy proposition that some unspecified but potent 'enemy' lurked in the seas and skies around Britain". The industry conjured up a new 'war' jargon, as in the war on drugs, on terror, on piracy, on genocide. 'The navy was needed to fight drug gangs in the Caribbean, pirates off Somalia and gun-runners in the Persian Gulf', he wrote. Jenkins continued: 'No armies were massing on the continent poised to attack. No navies were plotting to

throttle our islands and starve us into submission. No missiles were fizzing in bunkers across Asia with Birmingham and Leeds in their sights.'

Yet for the previous 20 years, he said, Britain's armed forces had encouraged foreign policy into one war after another, none of them remotely to do with the nation's security. And when Gordon Brown was asked earlier in 2010 why he was standing in an Afghan desert, he had to claim absurdly that he was "making London's streets safer". The ludicrous propaganda phrases never vary. On the lips of every current politician robotically promoting increased defence spending are the words: "To meet growing security threats."

From the end of the Cold War, NATO became an alliance in search of a purpose, as many advocated for it to be dismantled, in the same way the Soviet Union had dismantled the Warsaw Pact, as there was no more need for it.

The UK Defence Budget this year is expected to reach between £62bn and £70bn, prioritising capital investment over day-to-day spending, and MPs never tire of clamouring for more taxpayers' money to be diverted to arms manufacturers.

NATO does not wage any war for a defined end, but to maintain a permanent state of war footing, without any official

declaration of war. It has become the economic model of leading NATO countries, which keeps its populaces subdued, and is one of the most effective ways of transferring money from the taxpaying public to the pockets of the ruling class.

Greek economist and author, Yanis Varoufakis, told Owen Jones in an interview that when the U.S. joined Israel in attacking Iran, "it was lamentable that Trump had no Plan B, but it was even worse because he had no Plan A".

Varoufakis also stated that the U.S. was dragged into attacking Iran by Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu, whose reasons were the same as those for which he pursued the war in South Lebanon, the bombing of Yemen and the repeated invasions of Syria: because he needs to distract all of us from the ethnic cleansing in the West Bank and the genocide in Gaza.

He went on to say that the Knesset – the Israeli Parliament – recently passed a law which effectively cements Israel's transition from an apartheid state to a genocide state because it makes it 'legal' to hang Palestinians accused of killing Israelis in the Occupied Territories.

Varoufakis credits his friend Julian Assange with having made the point in 2004 that none of the wars that the U.S. was waging – Iraq, Afghanistan, Libya,

Syria, and so on – had any aim of victory. Their purpose was simply permanent war.

Varoufakis said: "It's a form of 'military' Keynesianism, the economic model by which the American economy grows, and the military-industrial complex is the industry policy of the U.S." Keynesian economics is named after the English economist John Maynard Keynes (1883-1946) and is based on creating demand. In other words, the American economy is sustained by killing and maiming hundreds of thousands of civilians in foreign lands, and a percentage of U.S. and allied military personnel. And we call it defence spending, because military-aligned politicians claim it is justified under far-fetched and easily disprovable invented threats.

But the grand halls and corridors of authority built on foundations of arrogance and self-interest are trembling at their weaknesses being exposed. We are in the age of reckoning.

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The industrial revolutions fraud

Rich get richer each time but it's sold as natural progression

THE World Economic Forum calls it the Fourth Industrial Revolution (4IR). History will call it the fourth upward wealth transfer.

The 4IR is sold as inevitable progress, but history shows industrial revolutions are not natural evolution; they are enforced by state violence, built on mass exploitation, and sold as civilisation itself.

Industrial revolutions are not accidents of history. They are the same heist, repeated every century, with better marketing each time.

The WEF tells you the Fourth Industrial Revolution is different. Smarter. Kinder. More inclusive. They told you the same thing three times before in history.

The pattern is not an accident; it is a design feature. Every industrial revolution has the same modus operandi: create a desperate workforce with no alternatives; use public funding to create private profit; dump the costs on those without power; use a marketing department to sell it as liberation

The 4IR is not liberation. It is the same transfer of wealth and power up the food chain, accelerated by better technology.

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The First Industrial Revolution (1760–1840)

The textbook version references British genius, the steam engine, the spinning jenny, railways and bridges. It was a natural flowering of human ingenuity that lifted billions from poverty and created the modern age.

The evidence shows that real wages in Britain stagnated from 1790 to 1840 while industrial profits soared. The average work week in textile mills was 60–70 hours, six days a week. Children as young as five worked as 'trappers' in coal mines — sitting in total darkness for 12-hour shifts, opening ventilation doors.

The Factory Acts of 1819 'reformed' child labour by limiting children aged 9 to 16 to 12 hours per day.

Life expectancy in Manchester in the 1840s: 26 years. In rural England: 45+. The industrial city was a death sentence.

The workforce didn't appear by magic. The Enclosure Acts (1604–1914) privatised six million acres of common land — 20 per cent of England. Peasants who had farmed for centuries were criminalised as 'vagrants' if they refused wage labour. The alternative to the factory was starvation or transportation to Australia.

When workers resisted, the government sent in the army.



The Second Industrial Revolution (1870–1914)

The textbook version highlights steel, electricity, mass production. Rockefeller, Carnegie, Ford — the visionaries who built modern America through hard work and innovation.

The evidence shows that Rockefeller's Standard Oil controlled 90 per cent of American petroleum. When workers at his Colorado mines struck for better conditions, the National Guard and Pinkerton agents attacked their tent colony. The Ludlow Massacre (1914): 21 killed, including children burned alive in their tents. Rockefeller's response? He hired a public relations pioneer to rehabilitate his image.

Ford's famous '\$5 day' (1914) was damage control. His Highland Park factory had 300 per cent annual turnover. Workers couldn't endure the pace. The Belgian Congo: 10 million dead for rubber to insulate electrical wires. King Leopold II's private colony — funded by Belgian banks, supplied by British merchants. The second industrial revolution ran on severed hands, a method for keeping a terrified workforce in check.



The Third Industrial Revolution (1960–2000)

The textbook version highlights the digital age, computers, and the internet, with Silicon Valley geniuses in garages democratising knowledge for all humanity.

The evidence shows that Silicon Valley was built on defence contracts. ARPANET — the internet's predecessor — was funded by DARPA (Defense Advanced Research Projects Agency). The first silicon chip companies supplied the Pentagon.

U.S. manufacturing wages flatlined while productivity doubled. International agreements destroyed Mexican agriculture, creating a workforce where labour was cheaper and regulations weaker.

As for the 'democratisation' of information, five companies control 80 per cent of global digital infrastructure. Google. Amazon. Meta. Microsoft. Apple. The internet is more centralised than the railroads ever were.



The Fourth Industrial Revolution (2016–Present)

The textbook version celebrates AI, biotech, the Internet of Things and stakeholder capitalism. Klaus Schwab's vision is of a harmonious future where technology serves all humanity with the Great Reset.

The evidence shows that Schwab's World Economic Forum coined the phrase 'Fourth Industrial Revolution' in 2016. Covid provided the catalyst. The result? The largest wealth transfer in history: \$3.7 trillion to billionaires in the first year of the scamdemic, while 160 million people fell into poverty.

AI is built on unpaid human labour. Time magazine exposed OpenAI's outsourcing to Sama, a Kenyan firm where workers earned \$2/hour to label toxic content. They viewed beheadings, child abuse, and bestiality. The 'intelligence' in artificial intelligence is extracted human trauma.

Biotech patents are publicly funded, privately captured. Moderna's mRNA platform was developed with \$2.5bn in government funding. The patents went to Moderna. The profits went to shareholders. The risks went to the public.

Stakeholder capitalism means BlackRock (\$10trillion assets under management) dictates corporate policy via ESG (Environmental, Social and Governance) scores. Not voters. Not workers. A single asset manager larger than the GDP of Japan or Germany decides which companies survive.



Tobacco ban a smoking gun

Nicotine law reveals intent to make us slaves to the system

TWO seemingly unconnected events occurred last month in UK law-making. However, seen in the context of increasing authoritarian disregard for human rights, and the ruling class's insatiable appetite for behavioural control of the population, these events are very connected.

The first event heralded the return of the body fascists, re-energised after their stellar performance in smashing overtone windows (the range of subjects and arguments politically acceptable to the mainstream population at a given time) during the covid psychological operation.

Place the entire world under house arrest and make their release conditional on agreeing to medical experimentation? The stuff of science fiction before 2020, but New Normal after 2021.

After successfully forcing the population to surrender their bodies to the medical establishment, how do the control freaks get their fix when they and the population have pandemic fatigue?

They pass a law to stop people from putting things into their bodies. You must take the mRNA, but you mustn't take the nicotine. Your body is not yours, and if you thought it was, the state has just sent you a memo to remind you that it belongs to the King, for he is about to press his Royal seal upon the Tobacco and Vapes Bill, which bans tobacco sales to anyone born on or after January 1, 2009.

The ban is sinister for reasons that will be obvious to anyone who understands the inalienable right of every human to bodily autonomy. To understand the seriousness of what has been done between 2020 and now, we must look to the most extreme form of body fascism that has existed in history – slavery.

The slave's body was literally the property of his or her master, to be used as the master saw fit, and then discarded or sold at the master's discretion. On a scale of 0 – 10, the degree of bodily autonomy that the slave had was zero.

Either you and you alone own your body, or you don't. If you don't, then someone else does, or at least has shares in it. And that makes you a slave.

Those who deny that mandated 'vaccines' or restrictions on tobacco usage, or any other drug for that matter, by adults are a form of slavery would probably base their denial on the severity of the bondage.

To this I would say: you haven't been forcibly carted off to work against your

lies on the spectrum. And if you accept this breach on the grounds that it doesn't affect you, then prepare for breaches that will cumulatively take us further and further up that slavery spectrum until we're on a plantation of some kind. I think they're calling it a 'smart city'.

The Bill is also cowardly, because the legal age at which you can buy tobacco is 18, and this Bill has been directed at an entire cohort who will only be affected next year when they turn 18. They can't object now, because they are minors not legally allowed to smoke, and by the time they might wish to object, it will be too late – the law has passed. So, the cowards in Westminster have picked a fight, but only with a minority who are not yet at the age where they can defend themselves and revolt. Divide and rule.

And the idea that these people care about

your health is risible and insulting to our intelligence. How stupid would you have to be to accept being told how to live by people so lacking in imagination that they chose a career in which all they have to do is walk into a building to vote on legislation they haven't read, because they are told which way to vote by their headmaster/mistress – the party leader.

This decision has not been made to "ease long-term pressure on the National Health Service". The best way to ease pressure on the NHS while preserving human rights and dignity is more and better staff, more hospitals, and less bureaucracy.

At any rate, if they succeed in enforcing this law, they will add numerous other arbitrary proscriptions in service of oligarchic control agendas. In a decade or so from now, you will not be permitted to put meat or dairy in your body, but you will have to put a certain number of bugs in your body, because... climate change, sustainability, the latest virus mania, saving the Blue Whale... you get the picture.

This deadly arrow is aimed at all of us. It just hasn't hit yet. But it will, if we don't stop it.

The second event referred to above was the announcement by the Metropolitan Police that facial recognition cameras will be rolled out across the country after a failed human rights challenge to their widespread use.

Online age verification has already begun and is ramping up. The scenario in which PC Plod delights in stopping smokers for ID is unlikely to happen. At least not in the

short term. This is because the Tobacco and Vapes Bill appears to criminalise only the sale of tobacco and vaping products to those born after 2008.

So it is not clear to me whether someone banned from buying tobacco and nicotine products, but who is caught with them, can face charges. However, the Bill makes provision for a broad scope of enforcement action that includes "the taking of other measures intended to reduce the incidence of such offences". It is also an offence under the Bill to buy tobacco on behalf of someone born after 2008.

Could such measures include the widespread use of facial recognition cameras? If so, and if you are one of those who cannot legally buy tobacco products anymore, what can the police do if they catch you smoking on their public spying cameras? I guess we will find out next year.

What is clear is that they are thinking of new ways to condition us into accepting that our bodies belong to the State, and the digital prison just got much more invasive. They are watching us. Everywhere. The further we move on from 1984, the closer we get to it.

Dark side of pulling a Moonie

The obvious Artemis II fake images are a distraction to create division

I WAS one of many curious people who posted extensively on social media about the fake Artemis moon mission.

Everything about it was so blatantly staged. The floating astronauts with suspiciously glitchy effects, the green screen anomalies in official NASA releases, the oddly perfect yet cartoonish views of the lunar far side – it's almost as if they were daring us to spot the fakery.

Why would those in power allow such obvious holes in their narrative to be broadcast worldwide? And why now, alongside the recent flood of Epstein files and other long-buried truths suddenly seeing the light of day?

I can't help but see a pattern. The elites aren't slipping up. They're letting the mask slip on purpose.

Start with the latest dump of over 3.5 million pages from the Epstein files in early 2026. Communications with billionaires, politicians, royals, and influencers – names we've whispered about for years now splashed across searchable databases, complete with videos and images.

Prince Andrew, Bill Gates, high-profile figures from both sides of politics, it's all there.

Why release this now? One theory circulating in truth-seeking circles is controlled demolition. The powers-that-be know the old system of total secrecy is crumbling thanks to alternative media and whistleblowers.

By 'transparently' releasing mountains of documents under an Act pushed through Congress, they create the illusion of accountability while burying the most damning evidence in sheer volume and 'redacted' information we are banned from seeing.

Or are they sacrificing lower-tier players and outdated networks to protect the core architecture of control – the real

blackmail machine that keeps politicians, CEOs and celebrities in line?

It benefits them by resetting public trust just enough to prevent total revolt. "See? We're cleaning house!" they say, while the same networks quietly reform under new names. For us? A partial win – more awareness of elite depravity – but also desensitisation.

When everything is 'exposed' yet no real justice follows (no mass arrests, no dismantling of the intelligence agencies that enabled it), people grow cynical and eventually numb.

Division sets in: some scream for Nuremberg-style trials, others dismiss it all as 'old news'. Either way, the spotlight shifts away from ongoing operations.

Now zoom out to the stars – or the studio set. NASA's Artemis II lunar flyby has been plagued by claims of green-screen glitches, AI-generated crew footage and visuals that look more like a Hollywood production than deep-space travel. Hashtags like #FakeSpace and #FakeNASA exploded online.

Why make it look so unconvincing when billions have been spent on the programme?

Possible explanations point to a sophisticated psychological operation. First, testing the waters of disclosure. For decades, the space programme has been accused of fakery, Apollo missions included.

By releasing footage with obvious flaws, the elite gauge how many are waking up to the idea that we've been lied to.

If enough people notice and question, it accelerates the shift away from blind trust in institutions.

Second, managed disillusionment. The old gods of scientism (NASA as infallible

explorer) must fall to make way for the new paradigm. As more people reject official space narratives, they become open to alternative explanations.

It benefits them by fragmenting the awakening. Some dive into flat earth or simulation theory rabbit holes. Others become apathetic: "Everything's fake, so why bother fighting?"

Meanwhile, real technological breakthroughs (or black-budget wonders) remain hidden, keeping the public dependent on the system.

For us, it's double-edged. Noticing the fakery empowers critical thinking and breaks the spell of authority. But if it leads only to despair or infighting instead of unified demands for real transparency? We lose momentum. The disadvantage is clear: a population too divided and demoralised to organise against the real power structures.

This isn't isolated. Look at the drip-feed of UFO disclosures – congressional hearings, pilot testimonies, 'non-human' craft hints.

Or the slow release of data on weather modification, vaccine damage, digital ID rollouts framed as 'convenience' and excess death studies pointing to medical interventions during the 'pandemic'. Even covid origins are now discussed more openly in some circles.

But why now? Well, there are several interlocking reasons:

- Pre-emptive damage control ahead of bigger revelations. With economic collapse looming, digital currencies incoming and surveillance grids tightening, they need to release pressure valves. Let people 'win' on Epstein or space fakery so they don't storm the real gates – central banks, WHO-style global governance or

whatever lies behind the curtain.

- Hegelian dialectic at work: Problem (hidden truths causing distrust), reaction (public outrage and awakening), solution (they offer a 'new transparent order' – perhaps with AI oversight, central bank digital currency for 'safety' or a unifying 'existential threat' like aliens/climate to justify more control).
- Desensitisation and predictive programming. Flood the zone with so much 'truth' that nothing shocks any more. When the next 'newsquake' drops – be it full ET contact, admission of geoengineering or something darker – the public is already exhausted and compliant.
- Culling the herd of sceptics. By making certain lies obvious, they identify and marginalise the truly awake while herding the masses toward approved 'alternative' narratives that still serve the agenda (e.g. blaming one political side while the uniparty remains untouched). They retain the real secrets (advanced tech, financial alchemy, spiritual/psychological control methods) while we fight over breadcrumbs. We risk trading one set of illusions for another. Cynicism without action leads to slavery by consent.

In the end, this wave of revelations – Epstein's web, Artemis' amateur-hour staging, the slow drip of forbidden knowledge – smells like a scripted unveiling.

Those in power have always operated on the principle that you can't control an informed population forever, so you control the information flow and the awakening itself.

They benefit by steering the narrative, preserving core power, and preparing us for the next phase of control dressed as liberation. We benefit from the cracks in the matrix but stand to lose everything if we remain reactive, divided or seduced by partial truths.

The real question isn't just 'why now?' but 'what are we going to do with it?' Demand genuine justice, not theatrical releases. Question everything, including the saviours offering the next 'disclosure'.

Stay sovereign in mind and body. The light is breaking through – but remember, even the lighthouse can be used to guide ships onto the rocks.

Keep shining your own light. The empire of lies depends on our silence and distraction. Don't give it to them.

Guard against safeguarding

Once-legitimate parental choices are now viewed with suspicion

WHEN people think of families with social services involvement, they think of alcoholism, single mothers and social housing.

While the working class do make up a significant majority of families within this system, this is far from the full picture.

Something I am seeing more and more often within my work as a family advocate is an increase in wealthier families, with much less serious concerns than we would typically have seen in the past, making contact with me.

This is due in part to ever more stringent safeguarding policies, and increasingly lower thresholds to meet criteria for social services investigation and involvement.

There is something else at play, though – something I have come to refer to as ‘affluency discrimination’.

In a bizarre turn of events, it seems that, in the usual fashion of the status quo, a problem was identified and overcorrection became the solution.

Just about everybody has now caught up with the fact that those of us who grew up accepting more work and less wealth as the norm haven’t really been getting a fair deal.

Generally – or at least among the more compassionate of us – it is no longer acceptable to judge somebody for their poverty, or to treat a lack of opportunity as a moral failing or evidence of an inability to raise their own children.

In an alarming shift, however, we are now seeing a change in perspective, where families are being investigated for the most minor concerns – or, more often, a combination of factors – that would never have met criteria in the past. Conscientious, active parenting is increasingly being met with suspicion.

While many readers will already be aware of the attitudes towards parents who choose not to vaccinate their children, there are other examples that are becoming more common.

Not only is non-vaccination appearing more frequently as a red flag for investigation, but families are also being scrutinised for choosing to immunise privately, where they have greater control over the schedule their

child receives.

In addition to this, private healthcare itself is often treated as a concern, with families attracting attention simply for seeking second opinions or exercising their right to access better facilities, shorter waiting times, and continuity of care. Many of my clients also report that diagnoses and recommendations from registered physicians are being disregarded by social services and the NHS.

I am witnessing families being scrutinised and cross-questioned for choices such as home education, healthy dietary habits, and employing help within the home. All of these share a common theme: they are more accessible to those with financial means and the freedoms that come with it.

Long gone are the days when people could comfortably watch the struggles of ‘that family down the street’ and assume, “that will never be me.” The pattern is no longer clear, and the net appears to be widening.

There are many reasons for this, from poorly managed and understaffed systems to increasingly low thresholds creating more work than can realistically be managed.

This combination often leads to culturally and socially incompatible pairings. It really is luck of the draw when you are assigned a social worker.

It could be anyone from anywhere, and any

walk of life, and if their worldview is so far from yours, you are at a disadvantage before you are even able to open your mouth to defend yourself.

In addition to this, we have low-paid, undertrained people entering the profession only to work within a system that was designed to assess working class families with a very risk-aware approach.

It seems more and more that we’re not just dealing with a system that aims to assess safety or risk, but simply to identify risk and note it down with no real nuance or flexibility. If you happen to fill enough of that ‘bingo card’, it doesn’t always matter how happy, healthy, and clean your children look, or what environment you’ve been fortunate enough to provide for them.

In a nation where the NHS and the school system seem to be held as the holy grail of our cultural heritage, anybody accessing anything outside of that is often considered strange, or even ungrateful for not wanting to rely on them. Families frequently find their experiences dismissed with responses such as: “Why are you complaining? It’s free, isn’t it?”

Perhaps we have become accustomed to expecting too little, or perhaps it is because many of those working within these systems come from low-income families. Either way, things that are considered perfectly normal in other

countries are increasingly being regarded as alarming or reckless by those employed to assess family dynamics and the safety of children.

In this age of often excessive inclusivity, we are paradoxically seeing people excluded and discriminated against for doing well in their lives, to the benefit of their children.

In this ever-shifting landscape, I strongly urge anybody who finds themselves in this situation to consult with an independent professional as soon as possible after initial contact. We no longer live in a country where there is any particular ‘type’ being looked for, and many variables – such as your local authority and the individual social worker assigned – influence how you need to communicate, and ultimately, your outcome.

With all of this in mind, there is neither need nor benefit in plunging into fear.

As always, the power lies in our hands, and knowledge is power. That’s why I am delivering self-advocacy workshops.

These will help you to better understand the structure of the systems in place and how to handle them, because it’s always better to have this knowledge beforehand if, heaven forbid, this should come to your door.

Fear is currency of control

Hidden hand is taking peace by manufacturing conflict for profit

ON the world stage it appears, with few exceptions, that every nation is defining itself as an enemy of another nation – and an increasing number are using this as an excuse to build up their militaries.

Diplodocus or diplohoax?

Making no bones about digging into dinosaurs debate

Jacqui Deevoy takes a look at both the scientific consensus and alternative perspectives on these creatures or creations

AS a child, I owned one book on dinosaurs. I remember staring at the illustrations and not feeling any connection to these giant lizard creatures. I preferred my book on Neanderthal Man and my etymological dictionary.

I realise now that I've always had good gut instincts. If those creatures looked like cartoons to me, then chances are they were fake.

More recently, however, I got chatting to a young man who was a huge fan of these prehistoric giants and claimed to have studied the topic for years. As a result, he was 100 per cent certain these dragony monsters really existed.

I told him that I personally hadn't seen any evidence to back up that claim but that I was open to seeing some.

He told me he had seen fossils in museums, read books and watched hundreds of YouTube videos about dinosaurs.

He said his friend in Mexico had been on an archaeological dig and that dinosaur bones had been excavated. I countered that none of what he told me was actual evidence. I mentioned museum exhibits being made of resin and asked whether it would be possible to speak to his Mexican compadre. He sighed loudly and labelled me a conspiracy theorist but stopped short of calling me a dinosaur denier.

I decided to go digging (pun intended) and examine both sides of the debate in detail, presenting evidence, critiques and possible motivations without endorsing any single viewpoint.

First up, the mainstream scientific perspective. Palaeontology, the scientific study of prehistoric life, asserts that thousands of dinosaur specimens have been documented since the early 19th century – not only bones but also teeth, eggs, nests, skin impressions, gastroliths (stomach stones) and trackways preserved in sedimentary rock.

These remains come from every continent, with radiometric dating methods placing fossils as being from the Mesozoic Era.

Supporting data come from multiple independent laboratories using techniques such as potassium-argon dating, uranium-lead dating and carbon dating. CT scans, electron microscopy and chemical analysis further reveal details like bone growth rings, blood vessel structures and even possible soft tissue in rare, exceptionally preserved specimens.

Mainstream scientists point to the evolutionary continuity between dinosaurs and modern birds. Feathered fossils from China, such as Archaeopteryx and various theropods, show clear transitional features.

The extinction event itself is linked to the Chicxulub impact crater in Mexico (google it and you will be treated to a graphic of an asteroid flying across the screen – perhaps introduced as a 'reward' that subconsciously reinforces the extinction narrative?).

Proponents argue that a worldwide hoax on this scale would be logistically impossible. It would require collusion among thousands of geologists, biologists, museum curators and governments across political and cultural divides for over 150 years.

Now to the sceptical/alternative perspective.

Critics question the completeness and authenticity of the fossil record. They note that many museum skeletons on public display are composites or casts made of resin, plaster or fibreglass rather than

entirely original bone. While scientists explain this as standard practice to protect fragile originals, sceptics see it as misleading – suggesting the public is shown convincing replicas while the 'real' evidence remains limited, ambiguous or non-existent.

Alternative voices highlight historical cases of paleontological fraud or over-interpretation, such as the 19th-century 'Bone Wars' between rival fossil hunters, which involved exaggeration and deception.

Some point to the relative rarity of complete skeletons and argue that fossilisation is an exceptional process requiring rapid burial in specific conditions. They question whether the massive sizes attributed to species like Argentinosaurus or Spinosaurus are realistic given biomechanical constraints and modern animal physiology.

A subset of theories proposes that the dinosaur concept was popularised during the industrial and Darwinian eras to support emerging ideas of deep time and naturalistic evolution. By presenting a narrative of ancient, extinct 'monsters' preceding humans, the story could psychologically prepare society to accept humans as products of blind evolutionary processes rather than specially created beings.

Certain religious interpretations draw on biblical descriptions (such as Behemoth and Leviathan in the Book of Job) to suggest that large reptilian creatures, if they existed, lived alongside humans on a much younger Earth framework – perhaps only thousands of years ago.

These perspectives are not widely published in mainstream

academic journals but circulate through books, documentaries and dedicated organisations.

Proponents argue that scientific orthodoxy can sometimes suppress dissenting views, especially when they intersect with religious or philosophical questions about human origins and purpose.

All well and good so far. I can see the discussion from both sides. So why does the dinosaur debate provoke such strong feelings? From the scientific side, the motivation is straightforward: evidence-based understanding of Earth's history. It's true that accurate knowledge of past life helps us understand biodiversity and extinction risks.

Those pesky sceptics, however, ponder deeper societal reasons for the emphasis on dinosaurs. Could the narrative subtly undermine religious worldviews by promoting an Earth billions of years old, making literal scriptural timelines seem untenable?

By framing humanity as the distant descendants of stupid, scaly monsters that went extinct due to a random catastrophe, does it diminish the idea that humans are uniquely created in God's image?

Both perspectives acknowledge that science evolves and that public institutions have a responsibility for transparency – clearly labelling replicas versus original fossils, for instance. At the same time, claims of systemic deception demand robust, reproducible counter-evidence.

The dinosaur question is no doubt a fascinating one and sits at the intersection of empirical science, historical interpretation, philosophy and faith. The mainstream position is apparently supported by extensive physical records, dating methods and cross-disciplinary consistency. But alternative views raise perfectly legitimate questions about presentation, potential biases in science and the deeper implications of how we understand human identity and origins.

Whether you end up concluding that dinosaurs were real, ancient creatures or part of a more complex fable shaped by human agendas, the discussion reminds us to question assumptions, seek evidence and reflect on what officially taught narratives reveal about our beliefs concerning the past and our place in the world.

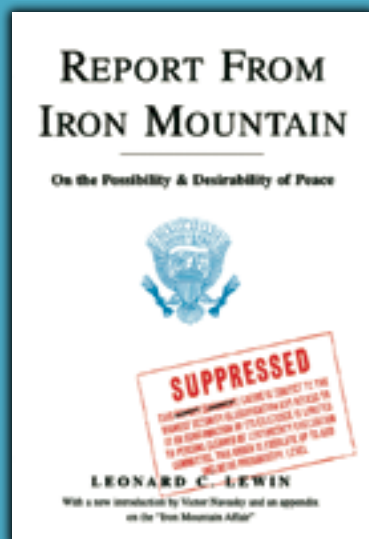

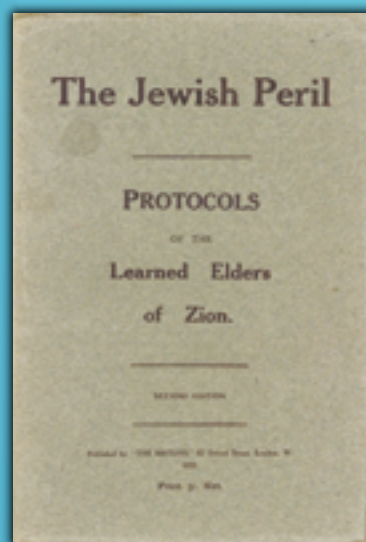

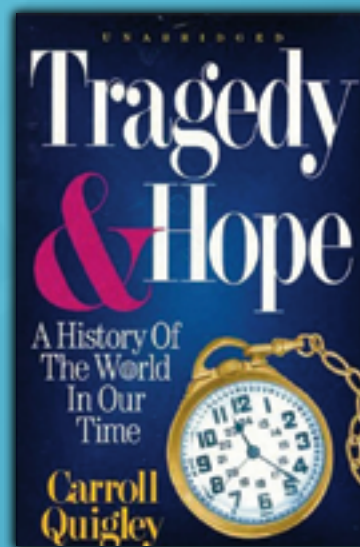

Cinema a catalyst for change

Heartbreaking Palestinian film puts humanity before politics

AS human beings, we build up subconscious walls that block changes in our opinions, especially on the big issues of politics, faith and morality.

Without those walls, chaos would rule, with people open to flip-flopping from one perspective to another depending on the information they receive that day.

However, those walls can also block us from seeing things without prejudice, and we will use pre-scripted arguments that we have stored away to protect ourselves from changing opinions on the issues that mean most to us.

These narratives that we build up are the bricks in the wall. And the bricks are bonded together by further information

that we subconsciously seek out to cement our strongly held beliefs – it’s called confirmation bias.

The wall is highly efficient at protecting itself – we quickly repair it with new, improved narratives if previous ones are no longer valid.

Occasionally, though, we come across something so profound that it knocks down the wall of cognitive dissonance like a wrecking ball.

For centuries, the demolition of our protective walls came through books, but, in more recent times, cinema has probably done as much to open our minds to other perspectives.

The ability of cinema to reach our innermost thoughts – perhaps due to the levels of emotion it generates with a shared audience – allows for the

magic of change.

A recent ‘wrecking ball’ film is one that addresses the plight of a Palestinian family surviving in a world of oppression across seven decades.

It was made to challenge embedded ideas on conflict and to confront our conscience over what some argue is genocide – it is perhaps a last roll of the dice for peace when all else has failed.

The film is *All That’s Left of You* and it brings into sharp focus the cruelty of war and forced displacement.

The director, Cherien Dabis, paints a picture of family life to tell the story of Palestine from 1948 to 2022, with debate on the rights and wrongs of zionism given a wide berth.

By telling a story of love, despair, rage

and guilt – seen through the eyes of one person across three generations – it allows for the rehumanisation of a people who have been subjected to a level of emotional and physical suffering that only cinema can fully express.

A single line of dialogue crystallises the entirety of the two-and-a-half hour film made in 2025: “Humanity is our resistance.”

But that resistance could not hold out indefinitely – at the conclusion of the film, we see the protagonist return to what was once his home city of Jaffa as an old man, now with Canadian citizenship.

The heartache of displacement makes him feel like an imposter in the drastically changed city, since named Tel Aviv-Yafo.

There is no hope offered at the end, only grief.

Horrific gang rape of Palestinian man ‘just tip of iceberg’

Please note, some readers may find the graphic descriptions in this article upsetting.

OCTOBER 7 is now routinely invoked as the explanation for the unbridled violence and psychopathic disregard for human life displayed by Israel in its recent wars in both Gaza and the Middle East as a whole.

That is just an excuse, however, to unleash what has been simmering beneath the surface for decades, now openly expressed across Israeli national conduct as a whole.

No clearer example of that condition can be seen than inside Israel's prison and detention system, particularly as it relates to the treatment of the Palestinian people.

The victims of the Israeli regime describe a system in which severe physical abuse, humiliation, and sexual violence are routine occurrences.

One victim, Abu Hassan, describes just such an occurrence after weapons were reportedly planted on his property by the IDF. He said: “They had an iron pipe and knives that they also used to beat us. They beat us everywhere, on our hands, on our chest and on our heads. Everywhere. They put out cigarettes on us, they tried to pull out my nails.

“They stepped on our heads and shoved our faces in dirt and faeces.” He said one attacker stepped on his head with both feet before jumping on his back, in an attempt to break his spine.

Abu added: “The violence continued the whole time. They urinated on us, and then someone holding a stick tried to put it in my butt. I resisted with all my might until he simply gave up.”

While the above incident led to an investigation and, ultimately, the dismissal of the unit's commanding officer by the IDF, even perfunctory investigations into such attacks are an increasingly rare occurrence. Indeed, multiple United Nations reports have documented the egregious human rights violations taking place within Israeli detention.

There is a pattern of escalating violence between the native Palestinians and Israeli settlers, behaviour which the Italian magazine *L'Espresso* recently came under fire for exposing. It is worth noting that the vast majority of such Israeli settlements are illegal under international law.

In my discussion with Gaza Humanitarian Foundation (GHF) whistleblower Lt Col. Anthony Aguilar, we noted that the Israeli occupation of Palestine is structured in such a way that it makes violence

practically a guarantee.

The former U.S. Green Beret described aid sites configured so that civilians were funnelled into controlled corridors, with lethal force routinely being deployed against unarmed and peaceful civilians. Though Aguilar was viciously smeared at the time, yet another GHF whistleblower has come out recently: former Royal Marine David McIntosh. Like Aguilar, he provided footage of the casual usage of ‘warning shots’ to steer crowds.

The Palestinian detainee and the Gazan refugee occupy different positions but are functionally treated the same – as something less than human.

Of course any discussion of this subject must touch upon the now infamous Sde Teiman detention camp. If the preceding accounts establish the structure and regularity of such abuse, this horrific case at Sde Teiman crystallises it for us.

Video has emerged of a gang rape of a Palestinian prisoner by guards at the detention facility in the Negev desert, southern Israel.

The footage, which news site Al Jazeera claims to have verified, shows the prisoner being selected from a larger group lying bound on the floor. The victim is then escorted to a wall, where guards, using their shields to hide their identity from the camera, proceed to rape him.

The attack is believed to have been so brutal that, after he was transferred to hospital, Israeli media reported that the victim was unable to walk.

Ten soldiers were ultimately arrested for the rape on July 29, in a case that has rocked Israeli society. The soldiers belong to a unit

known as Force 100, which is tasked with guarding the Sde Teiman facility, according to Israeli newspaper *Haaretz*.

Military prosecutors released three of the arrested soldiers on August 4, adding to the two previously released by investigators following a military court hearing in Kfar Yona on July 30, at which protesters gathered in support of the soldiers under arrest.

The male victim of this heinous and barbaric assault suffered “serious rectal injuries requiring surgery, a ruptured bowel, punctured lung, and fractured ribs. An Israeli medical staffer said that the victim arrived at the hospital in critical condition.”

The Israeli human rights group B’Tselem has done significant work on this subject, noting the conditions at Sde Teiman are ‘just the tip of the iceberg’ with reports matching this severity having occurred in sixteen different Israeli facilities. What makes the above case unique is not its severity but that it is one of the rare cases where such vile crimes were caught on camera.

Israeli journalist Oren Ziv said of those protesting on behalf of the accused soldiers: “Their sense of anger and surprise can be understood, because from the beginning of the war, since October, there was full or almost full impunity for soldiers.

“So we still don’t know why this specific case was investigated and is being proceeded. But we’re hearing much horrific evidence from prisoners that were released to Gaza, to the West Bank, and it’s not a unique case.”

Conditions and conduct of the most horrific

kind is routinely unleashed against captive Palestinians, from gang rape, to the usage of male dogs to sexually violate their victims. Indeed, as has been documented at length by human rights groups both within and without Israel, such events are sadly far too common; sexual violence, in particular sodomy, has consciously been weaponised by the Israeli state to break the will of the Palestinian people.

On March 12 this year, the Israeli military formally dropped all charges against the five soldiers who were charged. The military court did not dispute that the soldiers were caught on video assaulting the prisoner, merely that the video did not adequately satisfy the arbitrary evidentiary standard required to convict them.

Quietly culling the herd

Government of the people, by the people, against the people

THE world as we perceive it is not a system that has accidentally drifted away from its original noble intentions.

It is a control structure designed to operate by way of deliberate and absolute deceit.

The foundational lie – the one fed to the masses through constant propaganda – is that government operates for the interests of the people.

In reality, what we call ‘government’ is a carefully camouflaged control machine; a predator dressed in the robes of civil service to hide its true face.

At the heart of this machine is a simple, cold economic principle: the rate of return on investment (ROI). For the control structure to function, it must be able to bribe individuals in positions of authority to act against the collective good. This only works if the personal benefit to the individual being bribed outweighs any potential risk.

The system guarantees this lopsided ROI by ensuring that there will be no repercussions from the justice system.

If an official is offered \$100 to commit a crime that carries a ten-year prison sentence, they will refuse because the risk is too high. However, if the bribe is increased to \$100,000 and the system provides an iron-clad guarantee that there will be no charges, no prosecution and no conviction, then the trade becomes inevitable.

This is possible because the same powerful entities offering the bribes are the ones who control the courts and the prosecutors. They control both sides of the trade, ensuring that the individual can exercise their authority to do the machine’s bidding without fear.

The initial bribe is merely the hook. Once an individual takes that first payment, they are owned forever. The act of taking the bribe creates the very evidence needed to destroy them. If a government official later attempts to deviate from the established pattern of corruption or tries to act with integrity, the machine simply pivots from bribery to blackmail.

They are told, in no uncertain terms, that their protection has a shelf life. If they do

not stay on board, the evidence of their past sins will be released, their immunity will vanish, and they will face consecutive life sentences.

This is the standard operating procedure for government: a cycle of bribery that matures into a cage of blackmail, enforced by those who hold the keys to the justice system. This control machine is a singular, interconnected organism. Subdivisions like the army, the police force, the prison system and the judiciary are not independent branches of a healthy republic – they are different limbs of the same machine.

This interconnectedness ensures that those who serve the powerful are never held accountable, even if their actions cause the harm or death of millions.

The media acts as the machine’s primary shield, ensuring that these stories are never reported or are framed in a way that protects the structure. Through this total control, the powerful define what a crime is, and use selective prosecution to target enemies while protecting allies.

Even the prison system operates on unwritten rules where the powerful achieve whatever they want. In this environment, guilt or innocence is irrelevant. If the machine wants you in a cell, you can be falsely accused, convicted and sentenced to life. The only way out is to accept their terms, at which point the system will magically discover a misunderstanding and reverse the charges.

The most tragic aspect of this system is that it is maintained by the very people

it abuses.

The truth is so terrible and the reality of their own participation is so heavy that people would rather believe a comfortable lie than acknowledge the evil of the situation. They make excuses for the machine, claiming things are ‘getting better’ simply because the current level of terror is slightly less intense than it was before.

They cannot bear to see evil for what it is, they cannot create an appropriate solution. They are immersed in a field of deception that has no edges, making it impossible for them to step back and see the trap they are in.

We are now approaching an event horizon where the machine’s objectives are shifting. The system is moving toward a phase of ‘culling the herd’ – reducing the population and the burden of dependence. This is not a conspiracy theory – it is a programme currently being executed through medical and social engineering.

In Canada, the Medical Assistance in Dying (MAID) programme has already claimed over 100,000 lives, surpassing the number of Canadians who died in World War II. What began as a ‘humane’ option for those in terminal pain has been incrementally expanded.

The goal is to make poverty and mental illness qualifiers for state-sponsored death. By defining a significant percentage of the population as mentally ill through various prescriptions and government standards, the machine creates a massive pool of candidates for this culling.

The MAID programme serves a dual purpose: it reduces the population and provides a convenient cover for other lethal initiatives. If an individual is harmed by other ‘injection programmes’ or toxins, their death can be processed through MAID, ensuring the actual cause of death is never recorded on a certificate.

These multiple, overlapping programmes are designed to make it impossible to attribute the loss of life to its true source.

This is the design of the maze. It is a trap that is not meant to be escaped. The machine rewards those who promote its ideas and destroys those who deviate. Most people will continue to participate in their own enslavement, mis-attributing their suffering to secondary issues rather than the machine itself.

The system is operating exactly as it was intended. It is not a broken machine – it is a perfectly functioning control mechanism that relies on the participation and the blindness of the governed.

The only path to survival is to recognise the inherent evil of the structure and implement your own countermeasures. This begins with education – seeing the deception without the filters of propaganda – and ends with decisive action. Without this awakening, the machine will continue its progression toward the final culling, and you may not survive the process.

Globalist attack on children

U.S. state fights back against curriculum power grab

A WORLD Economic Forum-driven globalist technocracy is threatening to infiltrate state schooling curricula across the Western world.

The U.S. state of New Hampshire is currently at the centre of this cultural battle, the outcome of which will be vital for the healthy future of our children – and thus of humanity’s future more generally.

New Hampshire is a paradigm case of an existential conflict between local education systems and supranational entities like the World Economic Forum (WEF).

Systematic attempts are being made to bypass parental rights and local school board authority in U.S. states by embedding globalist agendas – commonly smuggled in under warm ‘n’ fuzzy labels like ‘career readiness’ or ‘future-proofing’ – directly into state-wide school curricula.

Yet New Hampshire spearheaded a welcome push-back after the leadership of the American Federation of Teachers (AFT) openly admitted to collaborating with international industry groups linked to the WEF.

In a heartening and empowering response to this globalist overreach, New Hampshire legislators have recently introduced HB 1448, a pivotal bill aimed at prohibiting the use of WEF materials in the state’s public school curriculum. This measure seeks to re-establish a wall between the domestic classroom and the influence of globalist organisations advocating the dreaded Great Reset and other top-down, technocratic social engineering projects.

This bill’s progression marks a major shift in the political climate, with more ‘awake’ legislators no longer willing to accept children’s ideological conditioning via the presence of non-governmental international entities dictating the pedagogical content of school curricula.

So New Hampshire is asserting that the education of its children is a matter of state and parental jurisdiction, being fundamentally incompatible with the centralised, top-down control that is sought by globalist institutions.

Not that any of this is especially new. Twenty years ago, childhood campaigner

Sue Palmer and I co-organised an open letter, signed by over 100 ‘big names’, that appeared in the *Daily Telegraph* on the theme of ‘toxic childhood’, titled ‘Modern life leads to more depression among children’.

In the letter, which went viral literally overnight, we argued that ‘children need what developing human beings have always needed, including real food (as opposed to processed junk), real play (as opposed to sedentary, screen-based entertainment), first-hand experience of the world they live in, and regular interaction with the real-life significant adults in their lives. They also need time’. While the letter wasn’t written from a fully awake place, back in 2006 we were nonetheless picking up on the toxic fallout stemming from an increasingly ‘over-technologised’ childhood.

The *Telegraph* letter was part of a wider early-years campaign Sue and myself were part of, called Open EYE, which launched a high-profile media campaign against New Labour’s Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS), irreverently but accurately christened at the time as ‘the Nappy Curriculum’.

A key Open EYE campaign theme correctly identified one noxious aspect of the EYFS curriculum, viz. the mass monitoring and surveillance of young children.

In more recent years, however, the globalist assault on our children has become ever clearer. Since Sue and I campaigned together, I’ve become increasingly interested in globalist agendas in relation to children’s education and schooling.

The modern schooling system has now arguably largely abandoned the goal of fostering intellectual independence, critical thinking and cultural preservation, and has instead become colonised by a relentless audit culture that systematically transforms public schooling into a globalist indoctrination apparatus.

It is designed to mould compliant, ideologically homogenised human capital who serve the interests of transnational

ruling orders.

This is very well documented, as revealed by many educators, whistleblowers and investigative researchers.

A few examples:

- The deliberate suppression of critical thinking in favour of standardised, outcomes-based learning that – incredibly – stipulates the legislated ‘learning outcomes’ before the learning process even begins.
- The over-sexualisation of young children with imposed gender ideology.
- Increasingly centralised control via global institutions like the United Nations (UNESCO) and the WEF influencing, and even dictating, curricula – with centralised control via the UN and the WEF’s Global Education framework and the UN’s World Core Curriculum authored by Robert Muller;
- The compromising and displacement of academic rigour with collectivism and dependency on state narratives.

Part of this globalist push into school comes from the Pearson Corporation. This multinational publishing and education conglomerate has played a key role in the technocratic globalisation of the Western schooling system, aligning with globalist agendas by standardising curricula, enforcing digital surveillance and eroding local educational autonomy.

Through standardised testing, digital learning platforms and partnerships with governments, Pearson has become a key architect of a kind of global education reset, advancing centralised control over the dissemination of knowledge.

At worst, Pearson can be argued to exemplify a kind of corporate fascism in the education system, whereby surveillance, indoctrination and profit-seeking merge in order to serve an emerging globalist technocracy. Its systems train children for dependency, not for liberty and freedom of thought.

I feel particularly strongly about the grossly developmentally inappropriate sexualisation of young children, with globalist institutions openly advocating following the World Health Organisation’s ‘International Technical Guidance on Sexuality Education’.

In the culture wars, there is also a drive to eliminate biological sex distinctions completely, teaching children that gender is ‘fluid’ and ‘non-binary’.

If I had young children today, it would be over my dead body that they would be subjected to captured institutional state education indoctrination such as this.

Home education is now the future for all parents who want their children to grow up unhindered into their full sovereignty as free-thinking, creative adults who will be the architects of the truly human future we all yearn for. It is the very future of humanity that’s at stake in all this.

Food taboos and the ‘ick’

Revolted by idea of human milk cheese? Here’s why

IN a world where most people happily devour cheese made from the milk of cows and goats, one question refuses to be skimmed away: why do so many recoil in horror at the thought of doing the same with human milk?

As a journalist who has spent years questioning mainstream norms and ‘acceptable’ truths, I decided to dig into this peculiar double standard. The answer might surprise you.

All of our lives, we have been conditioned to accept certain things without question. Every day, millions reach for cheddar, brie or feta, never pausing to consider that they are eating concentrated mammary secretions from another species.

The conditioning didn’t work on me, however, so I’ve always found the thought of all dairy quite alarming. Oddly, even before I knew where milk came from, I rejected it (as a baby I had tepid black tea with sugar in my bottle – it was the 1960s! My parents weren’t to know!) But the majority of kids were raised on some kind of milk. Even when those children discovered where it came from, they weren’t bothered. It was the norm.

But any suggestion of turning surplus human breast milk into cheese is met with gasps of disgust! Why? Is human milk somehow less ‘natural’ or more repulsive than that of a factory-farmed cow? And is it actually possible to do it anyway?

The short answer is: yes, edible cheese can – and has – been made from human breast milk. It’s not science fiction or a fringe experiment; it’s happened in reputable kitchens and art projects.

Back in 2010, New York chef Daniel Angerer famously created Mommy’s Milk Cheese using his wife’s excess breast milk. He served it in his restaurant where curious diners sampled the soft, slightly sweet result. Critics described it as ‘bland yet bouncy’, nothing revolting – just different.

Artist Miriam Simun took it further, producing varieties like City Funk (a human-goat blend) from screened and pasteurised donor milk. Tasters noted complex, funky flavours reminiscent of Gorgonzola with ‘unique urban notes’ (whatever that means). Other small-scale experiments and recipes continue to appear online, often blending human milk with animal milk for better yield and texture.

So how is human milk turned into cheese? Generally, any kind of cheese-making is straightforward in principle: coagulate

milk proteins (casein) using acid, rennet or bacteria, then drain the whey. Human breast milk contains the same basic components as other mammalian milks - proteins, fats, lactose - but in different proportions. It has lower overall protein (around 0.8-1% versus 3.3% in cow’s milk) and a different casein-to-whey ratio, making pure human milk cheeses

softer, more like pannacotta or delicate fresh varieties.

Practical challenges exist: lower volume, higher cost to the donor, and the need for rigorous screening and pasteurisation for safety (some believe that breast milk can transmit certain ‘viruses’ if unscreened). But with care, it works. Some even argue it’s nutritionally more appropriate for humans than cow’s milk. Well of course it is – that makes perfect sense!

So if it’s edible and has been used successfully in the past, why the widespread revulsion?

The real reason is cultural programming. It’s just not something we do! It’s weird! It’s gross! Some even liken it to cannibalism! But really? Is it any more

repulsive than the idea of eating cheese made from animal milk?

This reaction reveals more about us as humans rather than the idea of the milk itself. Disgust is a powerful survival tool, but it’s heavily shaped by culture. We’ve industrialised cow, goat and sheep dairy for thousands of years, distancing ourselves from the lactating animal. A neatly packaged block of cheese doesn’t remind us of a mother’s udder or her baby calf. We’re not constantly reminded – unless you live with vegans – of the horrors of the dairy industry and that a mother cow’s milk is specifically designed and produced for her offspring, not ours! Breast milk is for newborns, babies, growing children – it’s not for adults.

Human milk, however, hits too close to home. It’s intimate, tied to motherhood, babies and bodily boundaries. We separate food from human fluids in our minds, even though most of us consumed human milk (or formula designed to mimic it) as infants. Similar taboos once surrounded other now-accepted foods, and cultural attitudes shift over time.

Tomatoes were long considered poisonous in Europe, lobsters were seen as peasant food, often described as ‘cockroaches of the sea’, raw fish was viewed with suspicion outside Japan, and eating insects remains disgusting to many Westerners yet is embraced as a delicacy elsewhere.

Think about it: if human cheese became commonplace, the ‘ick’ factor might fade – just as many now love powerfully smelly blue cheeses that reek of rot and decay.

Animal dairy farming brings its own ethical

issues – welfare concerns, environmental impact and the separation of mothers from their young. Human milk cheese, by contrast, could use genuine surplus from willing donors, raising questions of consent and exploitation, but avoiding producing it on an industrial scale.

Regulators often frown on commercial human milk products due to safety and scarcity, yet we accept pasteurised cow’s milk without batting an eyelid. Is the repulsion truly about hygiene or is it more about challenging our carefully constructed ideas of what’s normal?

This isn’t a call to mass-produce human cheese. It’s an invitation to examine our food taboos with open eyes. Why do we celebrate one mammal’s milk and demonise another’s – especially our own species?

In the end, both are mammalian breast milk. One has centuries of marketing and habit behind it. The other confronts our deepest cultural boundaries. Perhaps the real question isn’t, “can we make cheese from human milk?” but “why does the idea disturb us so much more than the alternatives?”

For those curious, small home experiments with blended milks and proper hygiene exist online. But whether you’d try it yourself or not is another matter altogether.

As an aside, people have also experimented with making food from other bodily fluids too but that’s a whole other story – and maybe one for after dinner. If you’re squeamish, I’d strongly advise you not to go down that culinary rabbit hole.

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The horrors of hyperinflation

Germany 1922-1923

By January 1923, more than four years had passed since Germany's complete and total surrender at the end of the Great War. The poverty and hunger-stricken German nation was by this time having severe difficulty in meeting the extortionate reparations payments imposed by The Treaty of Versailles, and so, having already destroyed the value of Germany's currency, the Allies demanded payment in timber and coal.

Then in a further humiliation of already occupied Germany, 60,000 troops from Belgium and France expanded the occupation from the Rhineland into the industrial Ruhr region, and while innocent German children were starving, the Allies collected their stolen booty of German commodities. Machine-gun posts were set up in the streets in order to deter resistance, as Allied troops openly stole food and supplies from German shopkeepers.

Other than to stage peaceful, passive demonstrations, there was nothing that the disarmed, humiliated, hungry and helpless German people could do about this latest outrage. However, worse was still to come for the beleaguered German nation. With Allied troops occupying the Ruhr, and the German Mark losing its value to inflation, Germany was suddenly plunged into a horrific hyperinflationary, downward spiral. The socialist Weimar government and the Warburg/Rothschild Reichsbank had resorted to massively expanding the money supply and flooding the economy with their worthless fiat, non-commodity-backed paper money, mostly to cover the crushing debt imposed by the Versailles Treaty – with disastrous consequences. Hjalmar Schacht, the Rothschild agent who was currency commissioner for the Republic,

opposed letting the German government print its own money, and thus it was this banker-owned and run private bank that caused the Weimar hyperinflation. Like the Bank of England, the Reichsbank was operated solely for private gain.

On June 24, 1922, Walter Rathenau, the moderate German foreign minister was assassinated. Rathenau was a charismatic figure, and the idea that a popular government minister could be shot in a law-abiding society shattered the faith of the German people, who needed to believe that the country was in safe hands after the traumas of the previous decade. The wealthier citizens began taking their money from banks and investing it into commodities such as diamonds, works of art and real-estate – anything with true intrinsic value – and eventually, the ordinary German citizens also began to trade their Marks for commodities.

And so the printing presses continued on and on, producing the ever-decreasing-in-value Mark, and once they began to run, they were impossible to stop. The price increases became unmanageable. Prices could not be revised quickly enough to keep up with the speed of the inflation. A student at Freiburg University ordered a coffee at a café and the price was 5,000 Marks per cup. He had two cups but when the bill arrived, it was for 14,000 Marks. "If you wanted to save money you should have ordered them both at the same time," he was told by the proprietor.

Eventually, things became so bad that people would not even bother to pick up a one hundred million Mark note carelessly discarded, as by that time, it had become worth less than the paper upon which it was printed. There was a famous case of a man going to buy bread, carrying his money in a large basket, such was the

bulk of the notes he needed. Upon unsuccessfully attempting to enter a particularly busy shop, he reasoned that he could safely leave most of his money outside in the basket as no-one would risk stealing such a paltry amount of money. He was absolutely correct. When he returned, he found his money was all still there but someone had stolen his basket!

The presses of the Reichsbank could not keep up to demand, even though they ran through the night. A factory worker described payday, which was every day: "At 11.00am, a siren sounded. A five-tonne lorry arrived loaded to overflowing with paper money. They read out names and just threw out bundles of notes. As soon as you had caught one you dashed to the nearest shop and bought anything that was going." Teachers, paid daily at 10.00am, passed their money to relatives who hurried off to the shops. Banks closed at 11.00am as they had invariably run out of cash anyway.

When the 1,000-billion Mark note was first issued in mid-1923, few bothered to collect the change when they spent it. But by November 1923, with one U.S. dollar equal to one trillion Marks, the breakdown was complete and the German economy had become barter only. The currency had completely lost its value – and its meaning.

Then, a new president took over the Reichsbank: Hjalmar Schacht. Nine zeros were struck from the currency, i.e., one Rentenmark was now equal to one billion old Marks. The Germans wanted desperately to believe in the Rentenmark, and so they simply did just that.

But although the country slowly began to function almost normally again, the savings of the middle-classes were never restored, nor were the values of hard work and decency that had accompanied the savings. All those assets were literally subsumed into the bankers' considerable coffers, and with the currency went many of the lifetime plans of ordinary citizens. It was the custom in Germany for the bride to bring a dowry to a marriage, and as a result, many marriages were cancelled and many dependent on pensions found themselves destitute. People who had built up a sizeable pension fund found that their pensions would not even buy a cup of coffee. Such are the ways that the ordinary citizens of the world are cheated out of the money by these banking vultures.

Significantly, it was in the midst of this financial carnage that further devastated an already prostrated nation, that an unobtrusive former army corporal was thrust into the spotlight and promoted as a great 'leader of men.' The prevailing conditions of the time provided a perfect stage for anyone with any aspirations of greatness and the ability to 'mesmerise' his audiences with nationalist, patriotic rhetoric. Enter, one Adolf Hitler.

So, thanks for being the light for many people in this country and beyond.

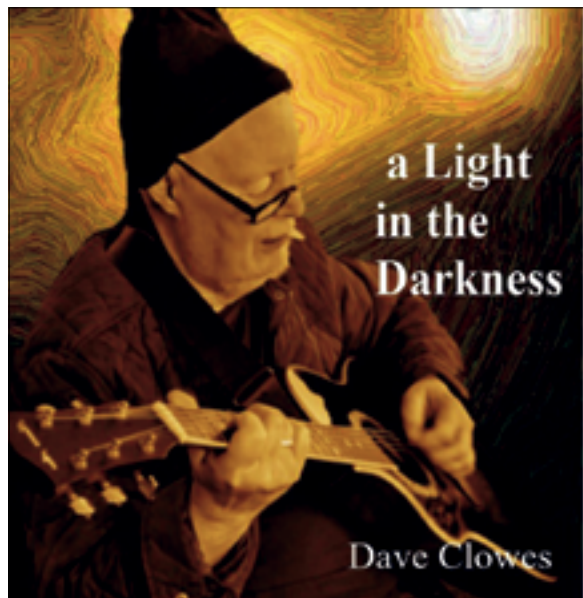
